From the Desk of Father Theisen



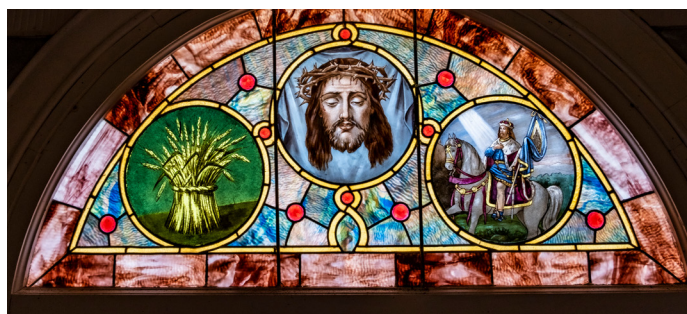
Padre's Pen – Windows

When we began the Capital Campaign in 2020 the estimated repair for the cemetery chapel was listed at \$80,000. This was for exterior repair for both the copper clad roof and the stonework. Tuck pointing the stone and replacing the roof. On further examination, the needed repairs far exceed this estimate.

The chapel windows are in dire need of refurbishment as well. At \$8,200 apiece, the six windows will cost close to \$50,000 alone. We are asking that people prayerfully consider sponsoring a window. It is a blessing that three windows have already been sponsored. The three remaining are: Jesus and Mary of Bethany, sister of Lazarus, Jesus and Dismas, the Good Thief, and the fanlight window over the chapel door depicting wheat, Jesus crowned with thorns, and St. Wenceslaus.

Bl. Karl's Corner

Bl. Karl found Austria/Hungary's alliance with Germany an uncomfortable one. It was an alliance based more upon language, as opposed to values and common goals. He felt that France, even post revolution, better shared Austria/Hungary's Catholic based values. But he was not in a position to choose allies.

The first step he took for trying to end the terrible war was to talk to his German ally. It must be remembered, WWI was not WWII and Kaiser Wilhelm, for all he was or wasn't, was nothing even comparable with an Adolf Hitler or a Josef Stalin. He was a man of his times, a ruler with ambitions, and he certainly made decisions Bl. Karl did not agree with. Still, Karl had enjoyed a decent relationship with Wilhelm, and he hoped that he might be able to convince him to end the war. Wilhelm's grandmother was England's Queen Victoria, as a result he was first cousins with King George V of England and Alexandra Feodorovna who had married Czar Nicholas II of Russia. For this reason, the First World War is sometimes referred to as the 'Cousins' War'.

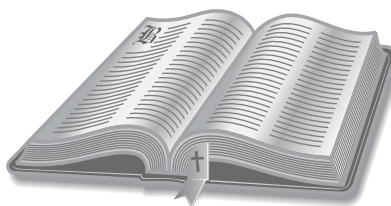
