Do you know that since 2000, there have been six Capital Campaigns, all of them having to do with reducing the debt that originated with the PAC Addition (which included a church basement remodel, playground reconstruction, school basement remodel, convent removal, and other upgrades to campus infrastructure):

- 2001-2003 PAC etc.
- 2004-2007 Debt Reduction
- 2008-2012 Debt Reduction
- 2012-2015 Debt Reduction
- 2015-2018 Debt Reduction and Parking Lot
- 2020-2023 Debt Reduction and: Boiler, Street Assessment, Cemetery Chapel, Church Tuckpointing

We are celebrating that we are finally debt-free - YOU have made a difference! A party we will have, but don't stop giving to the Capital Campaign. We have two more big projects that have not yet started (Cemetery Chapel and Church Tuckpointing). We will need everyone to complete their pledge payment plus additional contributions to complete these capital projects.

This current Capital Campaign covered five needed projects for the St. Wenceslaus Church Site:

- Debt Reduction (paid in full)
- New boilers (completed and paid in full)

Even if he had wanted to end the war, he knew his generals would not allow it. However, at this point, he agreed with them. Bl. Karl would have to take his peacekeeping plans elsewhere.




