From the Desk of Father Theisen



Padre's Pen - Fundraisers and Campaigns

I had the privilege once again of walking in the St. Wenceslaus Marathon with one of its founders, Ron McBroom. Once again, Ron beat me out on the fundraising end. Thank you to those who supported me! I am happy to defer to his many years of support for our school. We had a record fundraising effort for this year's Marathon... We raised over \$65,000 for our school! Many, many thanks to all who put so much enthusiasm and effort into the event.

Even better than a great fundraiser, Ron and I completed four laps together. The first lap was small talk between us then laps 3 through 4 we prayed a rosary together in thanksgiving for God's many blessings and for the continued protection and support for our school. It was very edifying to watch Ron every time we passed in front of the church. Ron would make the sign of the cross knowing that he was passing in front of our Blessed Lord hidden in the tabernacle at the far end of the church. It is very evident that Ron's support for our school and church comes from his great love for our Lord and our Lady. We are greatly blessed to have him and Kathy on our side and we pray God's protection upon them.

Also, it was an abundant weekend out at St. John's. We have been raising funds for the ongoing repairs at our Union Hill site through a generous \$50,000 matching grant donation. I am happy to announce that we went over our goal for the Matching Grant to the tune of \$51,200! As an added bonus our two donors have agreed to match the additional \$1,200. Many thanks to the donors for this fundraiser both from our parish family and from outside our parish. We have done a lot of work and are on track to avoid taking on any debt for these projects, as long as our good parishioners continue to fulfill their Campaign Pledges through the next year. The same goes for finishing up the work at St. Scholastica as well.

At St. Wenceslaus, we are incredibly pleased to be out of debt and hope to keep it that way for some time. Our two remaining projects from the Capital Campaign are the tuckpointing for our buildings and the repairs for the Cemetery Chapel. We already know that the designated amount from the Campaign falls very short of the need for the Cemetery Chapel. We have been able to cover the entire cost of restoring the Stained-Glass Windows through the adopt-a-window fundraising. I hope to get some grant money from the Minnesota Historical Society for the much-needed repairs to the roof and brick work. At St. Wenceslaus we are in the process of getting bids for the brick and stonework on our buildings here. The bottom line is, even though we are debt free, we do still need people to complete their pledges to the best of their ability.

Many thanks to all our parishioners for their prayers and support as we build up not only our buildings, but especially the Mystical Body of Christ among the People of God.

Bl. Karl's Corner

Throughout the war, Karl never lost faith nor hope in God, no matter how terrible things could seem. He still could imagine a life after the war. He still held his hopes for his countries and his family. He just needed to help bring about the end to the war.

On the Homefront, he and Zita had welcomed three more children into the world: Robert, born February 8, 1915; Felix, born May 31, 1916; and Carl Ludwig, born March 10, 1918. As things began spiraling down, Karl and Zita also emptied their closets, giving away their clothing to the growing poor population. He also put the royal horses and carriages to work hauling coal and other essentials to his people. As the world was rapidly changing, it became apparent, to a degree, that the world was about to be entering a post-monarchy world. Karl began working with staff to try and figure just what the Empire would look like in it.


