From the Desk of Father Theisen



Padre's Pen - Prenatal Justice & Mass of Thanksgiving

As everyone should know, our Supreme Court struck down the Roe v. Wade ruling this past summer. They did not make abortions illegal, but rather moved the decisions back to the individual states for legislative oversight. Minnesota already had inserted the legal availability for abortions written into our constitution. Nothing has changed in Minnesota regarding abortion except that we now have likely become an abortion “destination state.” As a result, the struggle for prenatal justice in Minnesota continues. There are two practical things we can do to keep up the struggle for life.

- Our Minnesota Bishops have put together an excellent statement for this election year consideration. Please read the statement. Seriously consider what our bishops are saying. Reflect on their statement. Research before November 8 based on our Bishop's guidance. And respond on November 8.

- Pray for prenatal justice. We have a great opportunity through the 40 Days for Life program. Our parish is signed up to pray in front of the Planned Parenthood abortion clinic next Saturday. Sign-ups for an hour of prayer are continuing this weekend at the west church entrance. Please sign up this weekend for an hour or prayerful witness next Saturday.

We have been very blessed in this last year in the many projects and programs across our parish. We have been able to accomplish a lot without incurring any debt. All our projects are natural manifestations of the supernatural care (grace) we have received from on high! As I mentioned in my homily last weekend, to have properly ordered prayer and worship we must have an attitude of thanksgiving. To that end, I will be offering an extra Mass on Friday, October 21 at 7:00 pm at St. John in Union Hill. This is the feast day for Blessed Karl of Austria and was the deadline for the matching grant fundraiser at Union Hill. We picked that date and place because we were calling in particular for Blessed Karl's intercession for the fundraiser. Nevertheless, we are giving thanks for all the blessings/graces bestowed upon our parish through his intercession and by God's mercy. Please join us if you are able. There will be a Latin Rosary before Mass and I will be coming over after 6:00 pm Benediction at St. Wenceslaus.

Also, when we return to Central Standard Time, beginning November 6, we will start a new Mass time on Saturdays. Instead of falling back to 4:00 pm on Saturday, we will move permanently to 4:30 pm year-round. Please call the office if you have questions.

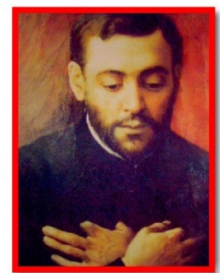

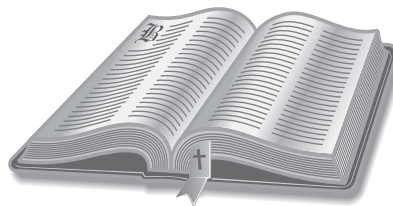
