

From the Desk of Father Theisen



Padre's Pen - Purgatory, Prayers, and Suffrages

We learned in last week's column that we can offer prayers and suffrages for our

loved ones who have passed and are in need of purification before entering heaven. The final book of the Bible tells us that "... nothing unclean shall enter it [New Jerusalem/Heaven]." Our suffrages/prayers for our departed family and friends assist them greatly in their final purification before entry to heaven.

We have to keep in mind that Purgatory is a great action of God's mercy that ensures that His eternal justice is also held in honor and implemented. The poor souls experiencing Purgatory cannot help themselves directly. There are instances recorded through history where the poor souls return and ask for help. (Note, we have put a number of books in the back of our churches called "Hungry Souls" that give a presentation of evidence through history of these occurrences. They are free for the taking).

The biggest help we can offer for the poor souls is the celebration of Holy Mass, but that is not the exclusive help we can offer. The holy Rosary is particularly effective as is the intercession of our Blessed Mother. We can receive Holy Communion with the intention of helping poor souls. It doesn't have to be a prayer either. We can offer even the smallest labor in our day for the sake of poor souls experiencing Purgatory. For example, I personally dislike emptying the dishwasher in the rectory and often let it sit hoping that one of the office staff (who use the kitchen also) will get to it. I could take that task on and offer it for the soul most in need of relief of their sufferings.


I do want to note, there is suffering in Purgatory, but also joy. The primary suffering is the desire to be with the God whom they met at the moment of death but had to draw back until they were entirely purified for the Holy Presence.

Finally, as I've said on several occasions, "We cannot outgive God in generosity." Not only do our prayers and suffrages work to great effect for our deceased loved ones, but they also draw us closer to God and help purify our own faults and failings. By offering our prayers and sacrifices for others we are imitating our Lord and Savior who offered the same while He walked this earth and continues to offer Himself to the Father on our behalf, and by imitating Christ He completes the good work He has begun in us.

LE SUEUR COUNTY CHRISTMAS ADOPT-A-FAMILY 2022

Adopt-a-Family for Christmas is operating through St. Wenceslaus parish again this year. Like last year, we will be using Sign Up Genius to choose families to adopt. As in the past, forms were sent out from the county Department of Human Services in early October. For children age newborn - twelve, parents fill out the forms listing sizes of clothing and outerwear gift choices. For teens, parents choose two clothing items from four choices (leggings, hoodies, pajama pants, or athletic pants). The forms are forwarded from the county to our St. Wenceslaus YAC group where they are numbered; names are removed to respect families' privacy. Families, individuals, or groups then choose a child or family to shop for. We also support the Le Sueur County Santa Anonymous program to provide toys, books, games, and other non-clothing items. Gifts from both programs will be distributed to the families on Monday, December 12 in Le Center. There are two opportunities to make Christmas brighter for these families: Choose a family and shop for clothing items. Or Donate Cash. November, The Month of the Holy Souls The Catholic Church dedicates the month of November to all the Holy Souls, beginning the month with the Feast of All Saints

on the first, and the Feast of All Souls on the second. St. Gertrude the Great, whose feast day is celebrated on November 16, was particularly devoted to praying for the Poor Souls in Purgatory. Tradition tells us that St. Gertrude was told by Our Lord that each time she piously prayed the following prayer, now known as the St. Gertrude Prayer, one thousand souls would be released from the bonds of Purgatory. Bl. Karl's Corner

The end of 1917 was a rough one for Karl. On November 7, Lenin and the Bolsheviks overthrew the Russian government. Karl could only watch the horrors unfold, knowing he had tried to stop it. On December 7, the United States declared war with Austria-Hungary. It was a cold winter and the people were starving. Karl did what he could with what he had. He created a Ministry of Social Welfare (the first) to try to help combat the hunger and disease that the war had brought to his peoples.

Deputies in Bohemia and Moravia issued an 'Epiphany Declaration', asserting their right to "a free and national life and self-determination"; strikes spread throughout the empire; in February a naval mutiny broke out. The empire was beginning to crumble. Karl had foreseen it. His sense of urgency in ending the war had been hastened by his knowledge that he had a lot of work to do within his empire and for his peoples. This could not happen, however, with war going on. Sadly, he had not been able to accomplish any of his hopes.


