A Note from Mary Bender - Parish Accountant



My name is Mary Bender. I've been working for St. Wenceslaus, St. John, and St. Scholastica this past year in accounts receivable and I've been blessed to meet many of you in one way or another. I thought I would take this opportunity, as the end of the year draws near, to address a

few items and offer a few suggestions.

We have been blessed by many financial gifts this past year. Most notably, the end of our mortgage payments and the St. John "Save the Steeple" project. What incredible accomplishments! I am glad I was able to witness them (I know many of you feel the same).

As you know, costs on just about everything have gone up. I feel it in just about every area of my life. Our parish feels it too. Just about every bill that crosses Ruth's desk has gone up, some significantly. Which leads me to this question: Has your giving remained stagnant the past few years? I ask because sometimes we automatically gift what we have always gifted, because well, that's what we have always done. If you're anything like me, it's hard to make a change; especially when it comes to money. But here I am, asking you to consider making a change: Increase your giving, if possible.

I understand this isn't something all of us can do. But you can still help us, and yourself, save some money by considering the following:

We can set up your donations to be automatically withdrawn from your bank checking or savings account. (The way many of you pay your electric, water and/or phone bills.) The benefits to you: No expense to buy stamps and envelopes, and convenience. (Have you, like me, ever forgotten your envelope at home?) The benefit to your church: No expense to buy and mail contribution envelopes.

The best part? It's easy for us to set this up for you! You can give by automatic withdrawal from your bank account on the 15th and/or 30th of each month. I have the authorization form you would need to complete (for me to set this up for you) in the back of church. The 2nd best part? No cost to us when you give this way!

Another option: You can set up recurring donations online. They can be withdrawn from your bank account or credit card. Guess what? It's easy for you to set this up! Just go to www. npcatholic.org Click on "Give" in the upper right-hand corner. Then "Online Giving". Scroll down and click on "We now offer online giving!". Create your account and you're done! (P.S. You can make 100% of your donation go to us by choosing to cover the fees the credit card companies, and our online giving provider, charge us to process your donation.)

I love it here at St. Wenceslaus. I sincerely hope you do too. We are a vibrant parish with so much to be thankful for. My desire to help our parish comes from a place of love and hope for financial security now and for years to come. Thank you for giving what you can. Please contact me if you have any questions.



Children and Teen Grief Support is coming soon. Have you experienced the death of a son/daughter, brother/sister, mother/father, or grandparent? If so, you understand grief and the huge changes a loss brings to every aspect of your life. Unfortunately, we have many children and teens in our community who have also suffered the loss of a loved one. We are starting a structured Grief Support Group for Children and Teens ages 5 to 18. Feast of Saint John the Evangelist and the Blessing of Wine. Let's fill the pews at St. John for the special 5:30 pm Mass offered Tuesday, December 27, in celebration of the Feast Day of our church-site patron, St. John the Evangelist. Did you know that all who attend Mass at a church named after the saint (the Patronal Feast Day) gain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions (sacramental Confession, Holy Communion, prayer for our Holy Father, detachment from all sin, including venial, within 20 days before or after), along with the recitation of the Our Father and Apostle's Creed on that day. A plenary indulgence is a favor granted by the Church through the merits of Jesus who removes completely the temporal punishment remaining for sins that have been forgiven in Confession. At this Mass, Father Theisen will also perform the traditional blessing of wine for the Feast of St. John. If you would like to have your wine blessed, bring the bottle(s) to Mass and Father will bless them. According to legend wine is blessed on this day because St. John was served poisoned wine. He survived because he blessed the wine before he put it to his lips. From this tradition, the wine is turned into a sacramental called the Love of St. John. This sacramental wine is used throughout the year for special occasions, as well as for the sick. At least some of the wine blessed on the feast day should be enjoyed on the day of the feast itself. On his feast day, we can drink it as a toast to St. John before dinner. The eldest of the house lifts his glass toward the next eldest and says, "I drink you the Love of St. John," who, in reply, says, "I thank you for the Love of St. John." This is repeated, continuing down the line in descending age order until all have been toasted.

Bl. Karl's Corner

Towards the end of January 1917, Woodrow Wilson delivered his famous 14 Points. Karl was very pleased to see another leader trying to do something in the interest of peace. The demands the points made on the Central Powers, were things that he had already been willing to concede in the efforts of peace. Naturally, the Emperor wanted a chance to converse with the United States on this. He and Czernin decided to attempt communication through Spain's King Alfonso XIII, a neutral party.

In February, Wilson added his 4 Principles to his 14 Points. Again, Karl was pleased with the direction things were going. He saw there was ground to work upon. A private channel was opened with Alfonso's help in late February, and Karl reached out, showing where he agreed with things, and where he did not. As a ruler in Europe, he had a better understanding of the regions, peoples, their histories, etc.. On March 1st, Wilson responded by asking for a detailed response to each of his points, and specific ideas on areas Karl had called out.
