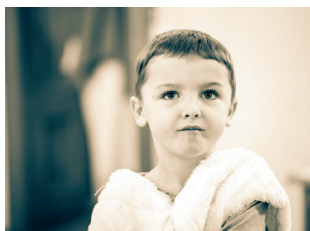

From the Desk of Father Theisen



Padre's Pen – Merry Christmas & Thy Will Be Done

A very Merry Christmas to our parishioners and our guests! Also, I pray you all have a blessed and safe New Year (we have one bulletin for the next two weeks).

As I sit here writing a column on a Tuesday morning with the winter crud taking its first shot at me (not much of a voice, so the parish staff gets a break from my dry humor and the morning Mass got a very short homily) and staring down the pike at a possible winter storm/blizzard in the coming days, I am reminded that the devil, the flesh, and world will do what they can to distract us from the celebration of our Lord's Nativity. Don't let them get in the way!

This morning's Office of Readings in my prayer book offered up a section from St. Bernard of Clairvaux writing about the Annunciation of our Lord to our Lady. He stated that, in her faithfulness to God, she "first conceived Christ in her heart before she conceived him in her womb." That is a beautiful way of describing Mary's cooperation with God's grace. God is a gentleman (so to speak) and proposes a relationship instead of imposing a relationship. Through the Archangel Gabriel, God proposed a radically new relationship with His creation by becoming one with us. The Blessed Virgin Mary accepted this radical proposal as the pinnacle of a life of faith in God. As I pointed to in last weekend's homily, this was both an act of "trusting in God" and "entrusting oneself to God." This should be the model for our own faith life.

God is constantly proposing a new and deeper relationship with each of us. For our part, we are called to focus intently on Him despite the hurricane of activity that surrounds us. We don't have the particular grace that our Lady had to be "Full of Grace," and conceived immaculately at our birth, but we do have the grace of Christ in the sacraments to draw us ever closer to the perfection He desires for us. How do we respond to make this happen? We take the words of our Lady and make them our own in prayer, "Let it be done to me according to your Word." (Especially when the devil, the flesh, and the world are imposing upon us).

Again, Merry Christmas and a Blessed and Holy New Year!

Have you experienced the death of a son/daughter, brother/sister, mother/father, or grandparent? If so, you understand grief and the huge changes a loss brings to every aspect of your life. Unfortunately, we have many children and teens in our community who have also suffered the loss of a loved one. We are starting a structured Grief Support Group for Children and Teens ages 5 to 18. Feast of Saint John the Evangelist and the Blessing of Wine.

Let's fill the pews at St. John for the special 5:30 pm Mass offered Tuesday, December 27, in celebration of the Feast Day of our church-site patron, St. John the Evangelist. Did you know that all who attend Mass at a church named after the saint (the Patronal Feast Day) gain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions (sacramental Confession, Holy Communion, prayer for our Holy Father, detachment from all sin, including venial, within 20 days before or after), along with the recitation of the Our Father and Apostle's Creed on that day. A plenary indulgence is a favor granted by the Church through the merits of Jesus who removes completely the temporal punishment remaining for sins that have been forgiven in Confession. At this Mass, Father Theisen will also perform the traditional blessing of wine for the Feast of St. John. If you would like to have your wine blessed, bring the bottle(s) to Mass and Father will bless them. According to legend wine is blessed on this day because St. John was served poisoned wine. He survived because he blessed the wine before he put it to his lips. From this tradition, the wine is turned into a sacramental called the Love of St. John. This sacramental wine is used throughout the year for special occasions, as well as for the sick. At least some of the wine blessed on the feast day should

be enjoyed on the day of the feast itself. On his feast day, we can drink it as a toast to St. John before dinner. The eldest of the house lifts his glass toward the next eldest and says, "I drink you the Love of St. John," who, in reply, says, "I thank you for the Love of St. John." This is repeated, continuing down the line in descending age order until all have been toasted.

Worldwide Marriage Encounter "Yet, O LORD, you are our father; we are the clay and you the potter; we are all the work of your hands." As we begin the waiting of advent, let us strive to become the work of His hands by attending a Worldwide Marriage Encounter Weekend. 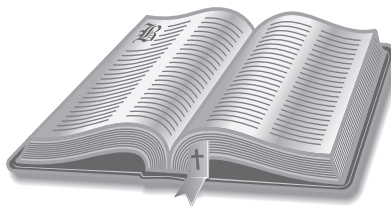
