# Padre's Pen – Merry Christmas & Thy Will Be Done

Happy Solemnity of the Epiphany and Happy New Year! (Notice, the feast about Jesus Christ comes first and then the

secular holiday.)

Wow! What a busy Christmas week. From snowstorms and being sick right before Christmas, to the Christmas liturgies, to four funerals in the week following Christmas, to the Mary Mother of God Liturgies, to an overdue visit with my mother on January 1, I was beat. On Monday January 2, I slept until 9:00 am (sleeping in for me is about 6:30 am). Then I took two naps as well during the day. Finally, on Monday evening I felt rested and was feeling the best I have been in the past two weeks. I got myself up and went for a New Year's Confession and offered Mass at about 8:00 in the evening. My body and my soul were crying out for rest.

SCHOOL NEWS from SWS Dear Parishioners, Parents, Grandparents, Friends of SWS, Happy New Year! We have many important things to accomplish in 2023 at St. Wenceslaus Catholic School.


