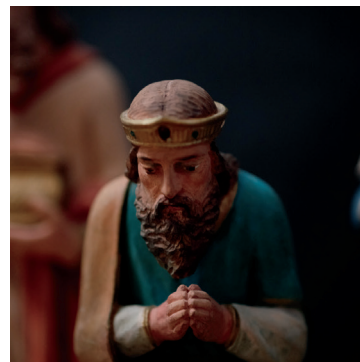

From the Desk of Father Theisen



Padre's Pen – Merry Christmas & Thy Will Be Done

Happy Solemnity of the Epiphany and Happy New Year! (Notice, the feast about Jesus Christ comes first and then the secular holiday.)

Wow! What a busy Christmas week. From snowstorms and being sick right before Christmas, to the Christmas liturgies, to four funerals in the week following Christmas, to the Mary Mother of God Liturgies, to an overdue visit with my mother on January 1, I was beat. On Monday January 2, I slept until 9:00 am (sleeping in for me is about 6:30 am). Then I took two naps as well during the day. Finally, on Monday evening I felt rested and was feeling the best I have been in the past two weeks. I got myself up and went for a New Year's Confession and offered Mass at about 8:00 in the evening. My body and my soul were crying out for rest.

While the body needs physical rest and good nourishment, the soul also needs rest and nourishment. Jesus himself took time away to go off and pray to His Heavenly Father. Nourished by the communion with His Father in Heaven, He came back to His disciples and public ministry refreshed and renewed in mission. After my day of rest for both body and soul, I am feeling refreshed and renewed for 2023 and the mission of Jesus Christ in our parish. I pray all in our parish take some time to rest in both body and soul to be ready for whatever God asks of us in this New Year.

SCHOOL NEWS from SWS

Dear Parishioners, Parents, Grandparents, Friends of SWS, Happy New Year! We have many important things to accomplish in 2023 at St. Wenceslaus Catholic School.

Goal 1. Our enrollment numbers are key to sustaining and growing our school programs. Gaining a few new students each year benefits all families and staff members. Having our kindergarten and preschool classes filled are critical to sustaining our numbers. Enrollment time is coming in January and February for families and we are hosting several open house/ registration events. Please also reach out to your friends, relatives, and neighbors. Invite them to consider our school in 2023.

Goal 2. School accreditation is a continuous process that helps our school focus on improvement. The school sets a seven-year improvement plan. During the 6th and 7th year of the plan the school does a full comprehensive study and sets future goals. The accreditation process also requires a review by the accreditation association to give an outside view and review to support the school's future plans. Our visit by MNSAA (Minnesota Nonpublic School Accrediting Association) will take place in spring of 2024. The outcome of these two large endeavours will direct our future. We pray for a successful 2023.

Catholic School is affordable! If you would love to have your child attend our Catholic school, but you think you cannot afford the tuition, then read on! St. Wenceslaus makes sure that every child can enroll in our school. We have a variety of payment plans. We offer financial assistance to families in need. 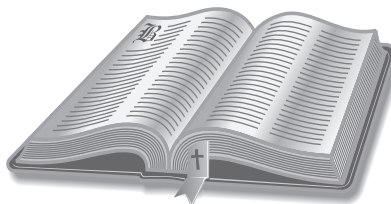
