

From the Desk of Father Theisen



Padre's Pen – "Ordinary" Grace and Sound Systems

I really love the hymn "Amazing Grace" but it really doesn't reflect a good Catholic theology of grace. So often when God intervenes in our lives it does seem rath-

er amazing and extraordinary. But in reality, doesn't God's intervention reflect His "Ordinary" love for us. God's love for us is constant and consistent. He wants to reach out to us and draw us closer and closer into union with Him in Jesus Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit.

As the power of the Holy Spirit touches us, we can be a bit overwhelmed. We are fallen, finite beings whom the infinite God desires to bring into eternity. God does not want that to happen only and exclusively at the moment of death. The moment of death is meant to be a transition into glory and beauty which we are to experience throughout our lives. The two great mystical doctors of our Church, St. Teresa of Avila and St. John of the Cross, would propose that all of us are called to be mystics. The mysticism of which they would speak is nothing less than experience of union on the deepest level of our being while in this world. That can and will change us and when we see it in someone it seems quite extraordinary. Many of us have seen this in our lifetime with St. John Paul II and St. Theresa of Calcutta. They stand out and appear extraordinary because they did not settle for mediocrity in the spiritual life.

As we are now in Ordinary Time in our liturgical calendar, the challenge for all of us is to accept and incorporate God's "Ordinary" grace in our lives. It may seem extraordinary to us as it happens, but it is our calling and vocation according to our state in life. It is accessible in the single life, in the religious life, in the consecrated life, in the married life. It looks a bit different for each of us. All of us should have a goal of being further along this path by the time we reach this same time next year. If we are in the same place, we are behind where we should be. Pray to the good God that He will bring us closer to that union in the Kingdom which is the family of God.

On another note, pray also that the supply line issues and the employment issues that are slowing the procurement of our new sound system will be overcome. The needed equipment is slowly arriving at our contractor and we look forward to everything arriving so we can get our new sound system installed this year.

Bl. Karl's Corner

Towards the end of January 1917, Woodrow Wilson delivered his famous 14 Points. Karl was very pleased to see another leader trying to do something in the interest of peace. The demands the points made on the Central Powers, were things that he had already been willing to concede in the efforts of peace. Naturally, the Emperor wanted a chance to converse with the United States on this. He and Czernin decided to attempt communication through Spain's King Alfonso XIII, a neutral party.

In February, Wilson added his 4 Principles to his 14 Points. Again, Karl was pleased with the direction things were going. He saw there was ground to work upon. A private channel was opened with Alfonso's help in late February, and Karl reached out, showing where he agreed with things, and where he did not. As a ruler in Europe, he had a better understanding of the regions, peoples, their histories, etc.. On March 1st, Wilson responded by asking for a detailed response to each of his points, and specific ideas on areas Karl had called out.
