From the Desk of Father Theisen



Padre's Pen – Thank God for our Catholic School

Next weekend we kick off the annual celebration of Catholic Schools Week. I'm going to write a bit this week about our school and Catholic Schools week because I have a column in mind not pertinent to Catholic Schools Week for next weekend's bulletin.

I remember back in the day when I was coming up on graduation and ordination. I, like many of my classmates, all wanted to be placed in a parish with a school. We all had high hopes for ministry and we knew how important the education and formation of our children is for the future of the Church and society. Almost 25 years later, I see how much I underestimated the important role of educating our children in Catholic schools (and I very much underestimated how much work and dedication it takes).

There are so many false ideologies and indoctrination efforts, and outright untruths being offered in culture, through media and in the public school systems. The bottom line is that Jesus Christ is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Because we are able to proclaim Jesus to our children in our schools, we give them a safe haven from the storms of culture. We give them a light in the darkness. We give them a way of virtue and character that has eternal significance. We give them the dedication and love of teachers and staff who are motivated by their own love for Jesus and their desire to model Jesus Christ to our Children.

After the liturgical life of our church in the celebration of the sacraments (which is the single most important thing we do), the school is our largest ministry. It has been an important and valued part of St. Wenceslaus Church from her earliest days. The Church and School are like the two lungs on the Mystical Body of Christ that is our parish. When both the school and the church (i.e., academics and active life of faith) are healthy, our parish as a whole will be healthy and have a bright future.

As we gather for our liturgies next weekend with so many of our school families, teachers, staff, and parishioners all at the liturgies, please take a moment to thank each other and encourage each other for the support and dedication all have put forth to keep our church, school, and whole parish healthy.

And most of all, say "Thank you" to God almighty above for the gift of salvation in Jesus Christ and the life of faith and education with which He has blessed us in our parish.

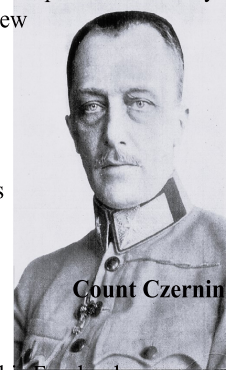
Bl. Karl's Corner

Correction: Wilson delivered his famous 14 Points towards the end of January 1918, not 1917.

On March 1, Wilson's response asking for a more detailed response arrived in Vienna. Unfortunately, the response went first to Karl's Minister of Foreign Affairs, Count Czernin. Instead of focusing on a response that could help end the conflict (for Austria, at least), Czernin was more interested in the spring offensive. As a result, he responded with only a sharp note, rejecting any concessions to Italy. Mr. Coulombe writes, "it was so sharp that the Spanish effectively lost it." He further writes, "What no one knew at the time was that Czernin had wasted the last chance Austria-Hungary had to emerge from the war intact."

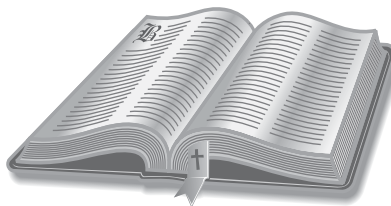
