From the Desk of Father Theisen



Padre's Pen – Reception of Holy Communion & Palms for Ash Wednesday

As we move toward the International Eucharistic Congress in July of 2024 in Indianapo-

lis, Indiana, you will see in our catechesis and life in the parish an emphasis on the Holy Eucharist (thus, the program in our Faith Formation Department called "Presence"). It is also a good time to remind ourselves about the proper way to receive Holy Communion. First and foremost Holy Communion should be received with faith and devotion.

To receive with faith is to believe that what we receive is truly the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. As the sacred host is raised and the priest or minister says, "The Body of Christ," the communicant responds with "Amen." "Amen" is an Aramaic (the language Jesus spoke daily) word meaning "So be it," or "I agree," or "I swear it to be so." It is the concrete expression of the individual's faith in the Real Presence of Christ. Out of that faith we come forward with a sense of devotion to properly honor and worship the Lord.

There are two ways in which we normally receive Holy Communion in the Latin Rite Roman Catholic Church: "Those who receive Communion may receive either in the hand or on the tongue, and the decision should be that of the individual receiving, not of the person distributing Communion. If Communion is received in the hand, the hands should be clean. If one is right-handed the left hand should rest upon the right. The host will then be laid in the palm of the left hand and then taken by the right hand to the mouth. If one is left-handed this is reversed. It is not appropriate to reach out with the fingers and take the host from the person distributing." (USCCB)

Some additional considerations are that we may not receive Holy Communion in a gloved hand. If one does not receive on the tongue directly, Holy Communion is to be consumed immediately at the altar and not walked back to the pew (if someone is bringing Holy Communion to a sick family member please talk to the priest directly about getting a pyx for transferring the Holy Eucharist). Also, Holy Communion is not to be transferred to a home for consuming at a later date.

Reception of Holy Communion is the most intimate thing we do as Catholics. It is both the sign and the means of our unity in Christ. More to come on this subject in the future. Finally, we are quickly approaching Ash Wednesday and Lent. I plan to burn last year's palms again for use as ashes on Ash Wednesday. If you would like your palms used for this, please bring them to church and place them in the boxes near the rear of the church.

Bl. Karl's Corner

Politics is a messy game, no matter who is playing at it. Karl did his best, but even that found him in a tight position. Germany had refused to look to sue for peace. Thus, Karl did so independently. He had told the Kaiser that he would, but overall, it was not something he made overly public. As the war raged, his people had to have faith that their leader was not abandoning the fight – which Karl wasn't, he just recognized it was a fight that was not worth the lives being ruthlessly spent. The letters Karl had sent with his brother-in-law Sixtus were agreed to be kept secret. For fear of German spies, the negotiations had to be held in the utmost secrecy. Also, no copies of Karl's letter were supposed to be left in French hands. If peace could not be reached, it was to be as if nothing had happened. That was the arrangement.

When Czernin refused to back down from his Alsace-Lorraine comments, France's Prime Minister, Clemenceau, declared this was unfair, as he had had a letter from the Austrian Emperor which gave his support for France's claims to the lands. Not only that, he had a second letter which established that Karl and his minister (Czernin) were in agreement on the matter....


