

From the Desk of Father Theisen



You will be my Witnesses, Gathered and Sent from the Upper Room.

Wow – that is a big job, but it is what each and every one of us is called to do. It is all

laid out beautifully in the Archbishop's pastoral letter of the same name. (Find it on the parish website).

Three mysteries occurred in the Upper Room; the washing of the feet, the breaking of the bread, and the coming of the Holy Spirit. Jesus shows us faith and service at the Last Supper. As the Apostles were gathered in the Upper Room after Jesus' death, they were fearful for their lives, they witnessed what happened to Jesus and did not want the same fate. BUT, they were then infused with the Holy Spirit, that same Holy Spirit that is residing in each one of us and it gave them courage to be bold, to go out and proclaim the Good News of Jesus!

From the Synod process that many of you attended, the Archbishop listened to our requests and developed three focus areas:

- 1. Forming Parishes that are in the service of Evangelization.
- 2. Forming Missionary Disciples who know Jesus' love and respond to His call.
- 3. Forming Youth and Young adults in and for a church that is always young.

Last June the Archbishop challenged all priests to choose 12 parishioners to be "co-workers" with him to build a parish that is in the service of evangelization. These apostles were chosen for their ability to draw others to Christ. It is the thought that these "12" will work to support missionary discipleship within our parish.

The 12 members from our parish are currently attending a 7 week course; The School of Discipleship. Through this process, we hope to take what we learn about our faith and transition to consistently living our faith in a way that gives glory to God. St. Wenceslaus Parish is a host site for the Discipleship course and is joined by 130 people from other parishes, including ten priests. We are very excited about what this process can mean for our parish, our Archdiocese, and our world! We are witnesses gathered, with the Holy Spirit infused and activated, we will be sent to proclaim the Good News of Jesus.








SCHOOL NEWS from SWS Dear Parishioners, Parents, Grandparents, Friends of SWS, Let's eat! The next few school events are


