From the Desk of Father Theisen

Padre's Pen – Announcement from Fr. Skluzacek

Good people of St. Wenceslaus, St. John, St. Scholastica, please read the following announcement from Fr. Skluzacek:

Dearest parishioners, it is with mixed emotions that I tell you that I will no longer be sacramental minister at St. Wenceslaus, St. John the Evangelist, and St. Scholastica beginning July 1, 2023. I have very much enjoyed celebrating the Sacraments with you these last four years. I have primarily celebrated the Sunday Eucharist and administered baptisms. I also help during Holy Week and Christmas. I have come most Sundays, except at those times when my seminary duties prevented me from coming. Most Sunday mornings I drove from Saint Paul to New Prague (or Heidelberg & Union Hill); some weekends I drove down on Saturday because a snowstorm was on the way. Fr. Theisen has been most gracious in letting me stay at the rectory whenever I wanted.

Last October, I asked Archbishop Hebda for retirement status starting this coming summer. I just turned 70, and priests in our Archdiocese are eligible to retire at age 70. Archbishop asked me if I'd consider staying another year at the seminary. After some weeks of prayer and discernment, I said yes. I love my work at the seminary and find it very fulfilling. However, I told him that my health and energy level is not what it used to be, and I'd like a lighter load. He agreed, and asked me to consult with the seminary Rector, Fr. Taphorn, to see what that would look like at the seminary. He also said that I would no longer have a weekend assignment as a sacramental minister. I will still help out on occasion at parishes, but not on a regular basis.

Thank-you for welcoming me and for all your kindness to me these past four years. It felt like "coming home" to New Prague, since I was born here and grew up near Lonsdale. You have a great parish, and you are fortunate to have such a kind and competent pastor in Fr. Theisen. I look forward to hearing of all the great things that will happen at St. Wenceslaus in the coming years.

The police informed Karl that they could not do anything until after something had occurred. Czernin was persistent about Karl's signing the release disavowing the letter that Clemenceau had published. He promised it was only for personal matters and would never be published. Reluctantly, Karl eventually signed it, and that same night Czernin had it published. Clemenceau responded with his proof of the letter and Czernin resigned April 14.

As one would figure, the whole incident greatly damaged Karl's reputation. The Emperor had been hoping to find peace and was willing to work with anyone willing to work for that same goal. Being it was wartime, he had to go about it in indirect ways, and sadly, they backfired terribly on him, as we will cover in next week's corner.

Two bouts with COVID-19 caused brain swelling, triggering symptoms of concussion damage to come forward again. This affects her everyday brain function; suffering severe headaches, passing out, is extremely sensitive to noise and movement, has a loss of balance, and her blood pressure and heart rate are erratic. Because of her health, she has been unable to attend school for 18 months. A functional neurologist has been able to help her, however, weekly treatments come at a great out-of-pocket expense. This fundraiser will help relieve the financial burden of the treatments. Maddy hopes for healing and returning to friends in school, 4-H and dance. She is the daughter of Mike and Gretchen Smith of New Prague and has 3 siblings.

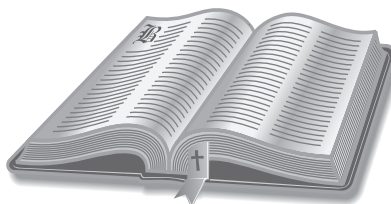
