## From the Desk of Father Theisen



## Padre's Pen – Prepare Now for a Holy Week & Pray to End Abortion

Saturday of this weekend, March 25, is the Solemnity of the Annunciation. This is the celebration of the Archangel Gabriel coming to Mary and announcing humanity's salvation through the Incarnation; God becoming man in the person Jesus Christ. When Mary says, "I am the handmaid of the Lord. Let it be done to me according to your word," Jesus Christ is conceived in her womb. Our Lord and God, the giver of all life takes on a human life at the very moment of conception.

Celebrating the Solemnity of the Annunciation now, as we approach the Paschal Mystery of Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection, is a poignant reminder to us that Jesus Christ came into this world to die for our sins, so we may have life and have it to the full. The fullness of life that He offers isn't just simply the "good things of this world," it is rather a recreation of our fallen nature to conform more closely to the image of God hard-wired into us from the dawn of creation. It is a call to intimate union and communion with a God who loves us so much that He both lived and died for us. Thanks be to God in Jesus Christ for this great gift! What are we to do and how are we to respond to God?

Next week we enter Holy Week. It brings to a climax the whole of our Lenten disciplines and encourages us to delve deeper into the mystery of God's saving actions in Jesus Christ. Set the week aside! If you are going somewhere for spring break, don't take a break from Jesus Christ! Look now for the local parishes where you can participate in the great liturgies of Holy Week. Whether you are here in town or travelling, plan for some extra prayer or spiritual reading time (which means turning off the TV, radios, and setting the phone aside). Pray for the many, many people who have fallen away from Jesus Christ and His Church and who may walk through our doors on Easter. Pray that God will convert their hardened hearts to live out an active faith. Pray for Christ to convert our own hearts to clearly see and respond to Him in our lives.

Christian prayer is powerful. Christian prayer during this holiest time of the year is life and world changing. Be an active participant in the change and reform that God desires for our world. Look ahead to Holy Week and plan how you can set it aside in a special way to honor Jesus' sacrifice and to give Him the opening He needs to accomplish the good work He has started in us.

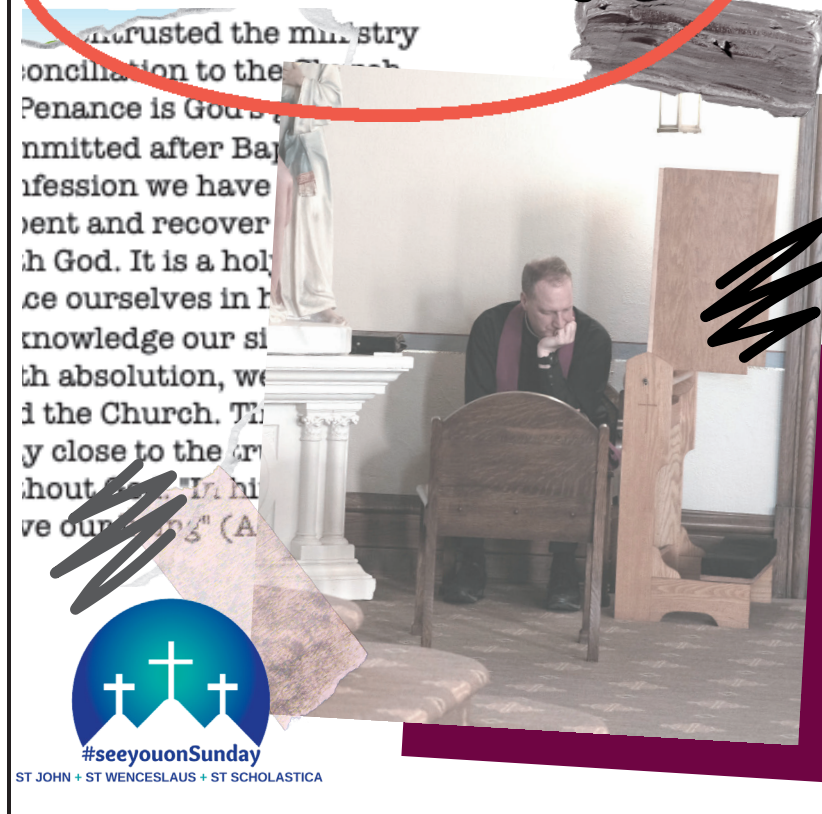

### Bl. Karl's Corner

The Solemnity of St. Joseph will be celebrated this Monday, March 20 (it was moved from the 19th, being it was on a Sunday). Karl had a great devotion to Saint Joseph, praying the Litany of St. Joseph every day. Each of his children received Maria and Joseph 'among their Baptismal names as patrons'. He looked to this great saint for guidance in his family life, as well as in his duties as Emperor, a father to people of many nations.

When in Switzerland in exile, Karl wrote this prayer to the good saint:

**Domestic Chapel, Villa Prangins, 21 April 1920**

*Saint Joseph, head and guardian of the Holy Family, in whose powerful assistance my ancestors trusted during difficult times,*

*I today choose you once again as my particular protector and intercessor. Full of faith, I place under your protection, myself, my house, and my kingdoms.*

*Graciously assist me from heaven in the struggle against the powers of darkness, who have risen up against divine and human authority. Conduct me back from exile into my homeland, and show my peoples, misled by deception, the way they might peacefully reunite under my scepter.*

*With a joyful heart, I will then repeat solemnly and publicly this act of trusting dedication to you, O holy patron. This I promise. Amen.*

This prayer was not answered in the way Karl had hoped, but we can be assured that good St. Joseph heard it and interceded on the Emperor and his people's behalf. May we all, too, seek St. Joseph's intercession in all aspects of our lives.

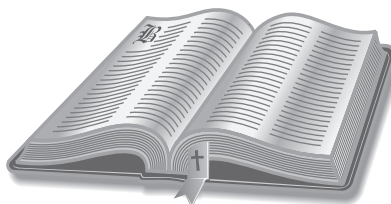
