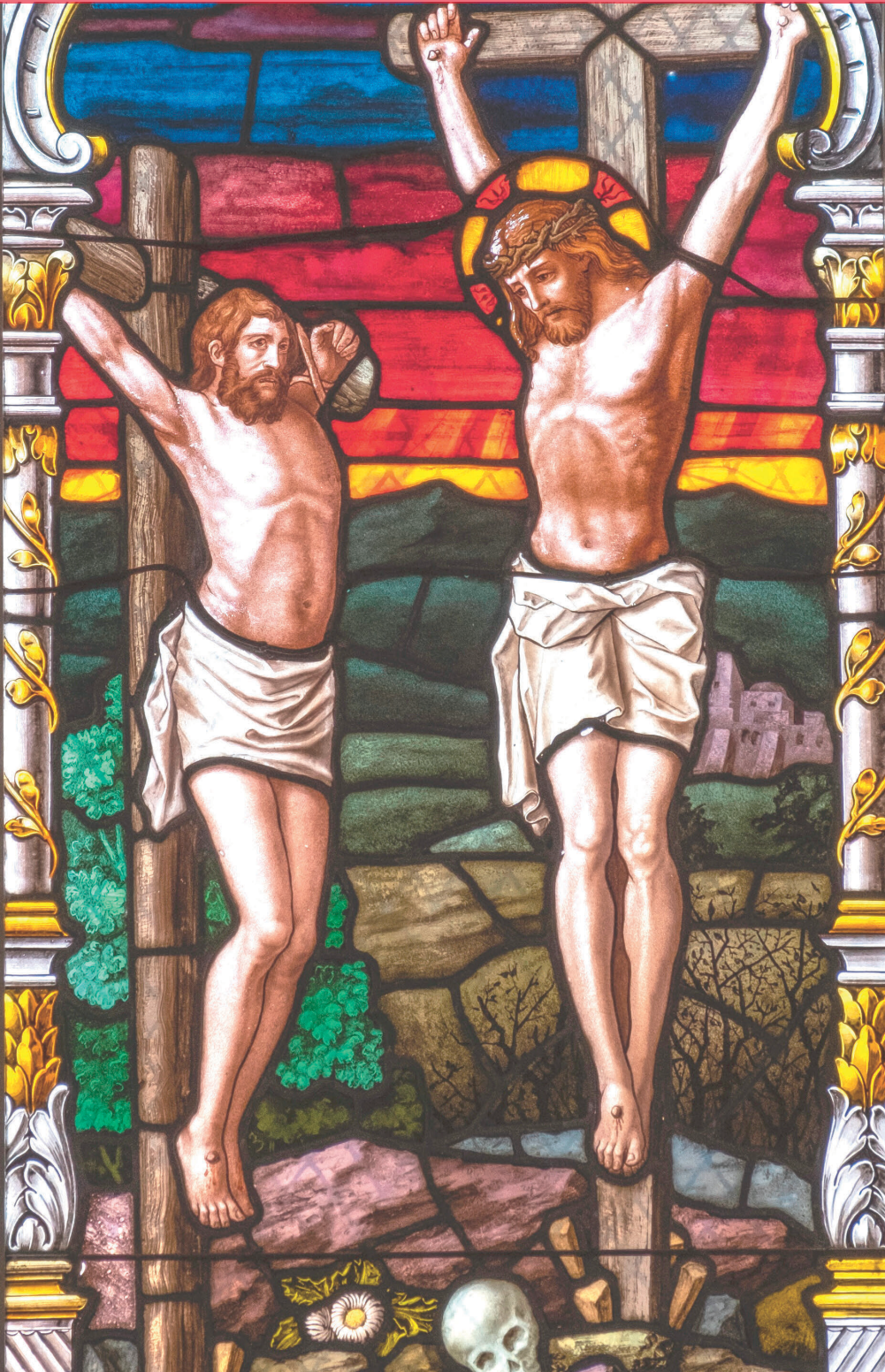

From the Desk of Father Theisen



Padre's Pen – Chrism Mass

As we enter Holy Week, I want to point out a very important Mass that most people pass over and don't include in their Holy Week liturgy attendance. It's the Chrism Mass. For most of my priestly life this Mass was celebrated a week or two before Holy Week for the sake of convenience. Its proper place is on Holy Thursday. Because of COVID, our Archdiocese has returned the Chrism Mass back to Holy Thursday. I am grateful for it. It's a busy time but it is more convenient and it really brings out the meaning of this Mass.

The Chrism Mass is where the local bishop blesses all the Holy Oils that will be used throughout the year for Baptisms, Confirmations, Anointing of the Sick, and Ordinations. In addition, it's the time where all the priests gather with their bishop (Archbishop in our case) renew their vows/promises and the People of God offer their prayers, affirmation, and support for their clergy.

As I travelled the world, I had the privilege of joining with bishops and priests everywhere to receive oils and re-affirm my priestly promises: St. Paul and Minneapolis, Cheyenne, Wyoming, Seoul, South Korea, Fargo, North Dakota, East Anglia, Great Britain. To the best of my knowledge, I only ever missed one Chrism Mass in my priestly life. In November of 2007 I deployed to Afghanistan and did not return until early summer of 2008. Nevertheless, I took with me the prayers and reaffirmations done at every Chrism Mass and I spent a Holy Hour in prayer re-affirming my promises. It has made a difference in my life! This Mass is open to the public. I invite and exhort any and all who can make it to come to the Cathedral in St. Paul for this Mass at 10:00 am. This is where we will receive our Oil of the Sick that I use for anointings in our parish. We receive the Oil of Catechumens for use in all our Baptisms. The Oil of Chrism from this Mass will be used for the Confirmations and Professions of Faith later this spring.

The power of Christian prayer, The Archbishop, bishops, priests, deacons, and laity all gathered together praying for the Holy Spirit to come and bless these oils will have its effects. This ought not to be something just the "clergy does." It is the whole Mystical Body of Christ gathered in confidence that the sacramental life of the Church is the Divine Life of God poured into His people through these same sacraments. It has its effects in proportion to our faith and our participation. It can and will make a difference in our parish life.

Finally, it's always nice at a bigger liturgy like this to look into the crowd and see parishioners from here smiling back at me.

Date: Holy Saturday, April 8, 2023

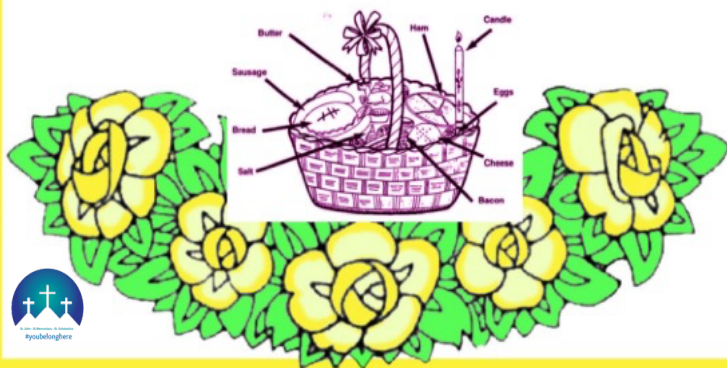
Time: 10:30 a.m.

Please bring your basket loaded with the foods, cooked or uncooked, you will serve for Easter dinner, so Father Theisen can bless them on Holy Saturday morning.

You may want to include some of the following traditional items:

- Bread - symbolizing Jesus, the Bread of Life
- Easter Eggs - symbolizing our new life in Christ
- Salt - to remind us that Jesus did not undergo corruption in the grave
- Meat - symbolizing joy and abundance
- Candle - symbolizing Christ, the Light of the World
- Ribbons - symbolizing joy and celebration
- Linen Cloth/Lace Napkin - lining and/or covering the basket to symbolize Christ's burial shroud
- Any other items you want - chocolates, desserts, etc.

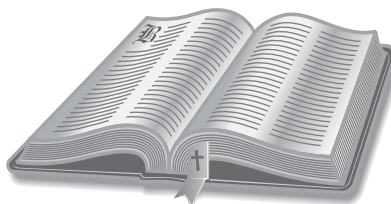
