## PADRE'S PEN – SOUND SYSTEMS AND MAINTENANCE

Greetings and Easter Blessings on this third Sunday celebration of the Resurrection of our Lord. A few updates for you this week:

**Sound System** - Just before Easter I contacted EMI (the company contracted to install our new sound system). The sound system components are still arriving slowly at their warehouse due to the supply chain issues our whole country has been experiencing. As of Friday, March 31, they were in the process of painting our speakers, so they will match the color of our church. Also, all components for the new system have arrived, except the wireless microphones. They do not yet have a potential delivery date for those yet. We are patiently waiting and hoping that our entire system will be in soon.

**Construction around St. Wenceslaus** - There will be a lot of activity on our roofs to repair/replace damage from last summer's hailstorm.

Also, you will see a lot of activity on the north side of the rectory. Through some generous donors who want to help prepare for the possibility of a second resident priest next year and to get our own parish vehicle into the garage and out of the elements, we have gone through the process to get bids and all the proper approvals (parish and finance councils, city, and Archdiocese) for a garage addition. This will be a two-car addition as well as some rectory sewer line work (as a preventative maintenance measure, remove and replace the old clay/tile sewer line to the city sewer system). This work will coincide with the roof work from the hail damage, so there will be a seamless transition from the current garage to the new section. There will be matching brick so that the look of our campus does not significantly change. On that note, we had three generous donors for this project. We are looking to top off the total cost of the project from any other donors. We are in need of about \$13,000 more.

If there is anyone interested in helping with this remaining balance, please contact me and we can sit down over some coffee, and I'll give the particulars on the whole project.

**Construction at St. John and St. Scholastica** - We continue with our efforts out west. We are finishing the north and east faces of the steeple at St. John as well as completing a handicap-accessible bathroom in Koenig Hall. We are looking at some landscaping work to get the water properly drained away from the north side of the church. At St. Scholastica, we have some interior roofing work to complete in the sacristy area and get our cabinetry re-installed in that area.

While funds are getting tighter, we have not had to seek any loans at any of our sites for any of the work we are doing and still remain debt free. Again, any additional donations for our maintenance and upkeep work are greatly appreciated.

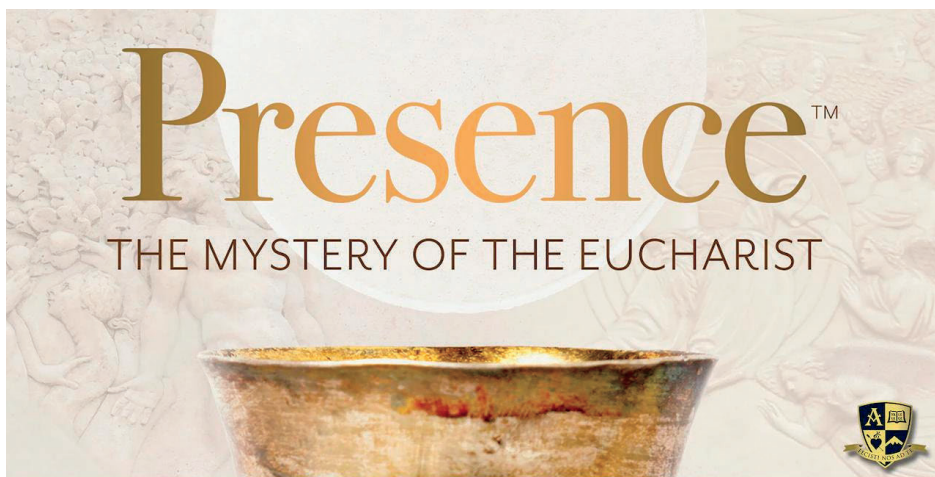
