## YOU'RE INVITED!

The Church of St. Peter, in Mendota, is hosting the International Vatican Eucharistic Miracles Exhibit on June 16, 17, and 18. What is a Eucharistic miracle? Eucharistic miracles are extraordinary events or phenomena, which manifest the Real Presence of Jesus in the consecrated bread and wine in a way that we can discern with our ordinary senses. The manifestation may be as simple as a host floating on air or as astonishing as a host becoming visible human flesh. This international exhibition was created and designed by Blessed Carlo Acutis in 2002. It consists of an extensive collection of photographs and historical records representing a sampling of ancient and modern Eucharistic miracles that have taken place in various parts of the world. The collection was assembled by the Vatican to mark the Year of the Eucharist (2004-2005). After being shown at more than 500 parishes in Italy, it is now traveling the rest of the world.

Please join us as we journey (hopefully by bus) there on Friday, June 16. We will leave St. Wencelaus at 7:45 am and celebrate Mass at St. Peter at 9:00 am. Daily Mass at St. Peter is held in the historic church, the oldest Catholic Church in Minnesota. Below is a tentative itinerary for the day.

- Leave St. Wenceslaus for the Church of St. Peter at 7:45 am.
- Mass at St. Peter's at 9:00 am in the historic church. View exhibit 9:45 am – 12:30 pm.
- Bus leaves St. Peter's for lunch at 12:45 pm.
- Arrive at Eagan's Promenade Shopping Center around 1:00 pm.
- Lunch/free time 1:00 pm – 2:30 pm.
- Leave the mall for New Prague at 2:30 pm and arrive back in New Prague at 3:15 pm.

With these words, Carlo Acutis, a teen who died after a swift battle with leukemia, outlines the distinguishing feature of his brief existence: to live with Jesus, for Jesus, and in Jesus. Carlo also asks the same thing of us - to emulate the Gospel with our life, so that we can be a beacon lighting the way for others. Carlo's love and reverence for the Eucharist were exceptional and he had many worthy words about it: "The Eucharist is my highway to Heaven!" and, "If we get in front of the sun, we get sun tans, but when we get in front of Jesus in the Eucharist, we become Saints." From an early age, Carlo started compiling examples of Eucharistic miracles. Please come with us to view his short life's work.

## Blessed Karl's Corner -

Karl attempted to be a peacemaker, both within his kingdom among his various peoples and abroad. Again, we see where his intercession is fitting to our times of various hostilities. Karl was a model husband and father too. Because the life of the family is under strain in our modern time, we can seek Karl and Zita's intercession. They both lived through tough times, marked by hardship, heartbreak, and great changes. But through it all, they worked to keep the integrity of their family, recognizing its important role in God's earthly kingdom.

## The Holy Rosary

The most popular prayer after the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the Holy Rosary, to which many popes have richly granted indulgences. Coming from Latin, rosary means 'a garland of roses', indicating that through reciting it, we should gather 'flowers of piety' to 'place' at Our Lady's feet, and the 'fruits of every virtue' to instill into our hearts. Legend has it that, as a young monk prayed the Hail Marys of the Rosary, Mary took his Aves as rosebuds, symbolizing love, and wove them into a garland to place on her head.

Mother Mary appeared in 1214 with a rosary in her hand to St. Dominic Guzman, as an answer to his prayers for her help during the Albigensian heresy which was destroying Christendom at that time. Teaching him how to pray the Rosary as she wanted, and encouraging its widespread use, she further revealed to St. Dominic and later to Blessed Alain de la Roche, a Dominican priest, promises for the faithful who devoutly pray the Rosary. Blessed Alain made known the "fifteen rosary promises," and promoted that people pray the Rosary in groups, forever altering the way people pray this.

As Pope St. Pius V ordered the worldwide recitation of the Holy Rosary in 1571 to deliver Western Christendom from the Turks, we, too, should also turn to the most powerful weapon, the Rosary, against the evil of our times, as we are still threatened by many hostile powers. Whether you pray the Rosary or a decade of it daily, have fallen away from praying it, or do not know how to pray it, this month of May, Mary's month, is a perfect time to continue to pick up your rosaries, to recommit to praying it, or to make the time to learn how. Father Patrick Peyton, the modern apostle of the Family Rosary, said it best in, "the family that prays together, stays together," and "A world at prayer is a world at peace." Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, pray for us!
