July, The Month of the Most Precious Blood of Jesus.

The month of July is traditionally dedicated to the Most Precious Blood of Jesus, beginning back in August 1849, as a reminder to all Catholics to remember Jesus' profound sacrifice for our salvation with the pouring out of His blood for humanity. Pope Pius IX, along with Don Giovanni Merlini, a professed member of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood, were exiled to Gaeta in 1849 during the First Italian War for Independence. During this time, with the war still raging, Merlini suggested to Pope Pius IX the creation of a universal feast dedicated to the Most Precious Blood, begging for Heavenly aid from God to end the war and bring peace to Rome. Heeding that suggestion, the pope stated his intention to create a feast in honor of the Most Precious Blood. Soon after, the war did come to an end, and Pope Pius IX returned to Rome. He made the feast official, proclaiming the 1st Sunday in July be dedicated to the Most Precious Blood, which he later changed to the fixed date of July 1. However, the feast was removed from the church calendar after Vatican II, with a Votive Mass being instituted that can be celebrated in the month of July. While in exile, Pope Pius IX turned to the Blood of Christ for strength, and from that, we have been given a month, July, dedicated to the Most Precious Blood of Jesus Christ.

Blessed Karl's Corner -

As per the plan that Austria and France had agreed upon, Karl sent a letter to the Kaiser denying negotiations, which was to be the signal for France to drop the subject, but France did not. Instead, Clemenceau made known he had a copy of a letter and a note from Czernin which acknowledged France's claim to the Alsace-Lorraine. Karl sent the Kaiser a telegram assuring him of Austria's support. Wilhelm sent back a favorable reply. Clemenceau then had the letter published. Czernin, wishing to distance himself from the whole messy business that he had pushed along, demanded that Karl sign a release disavowing the published letter. The following morning, Karl had a mild heart attack and was unavailable. So Czernin raved at Zita, telling her how Karl must sign the release or Germany might invade Austria, which was, as author Charles Coulombe said, "a real possibility..."
