## August: The Month of the Immaculate Heart of Mary

According to the church calendar, the month of August is traditionally dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. This beautiful, pure, immaculate heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our heavenly mother, is overflowing with love, not only for her beloved Son but for all of us, whom she takes as her children. May we be a reflection of her heart, by radiating, even a portion of, that love back to her, to Jesus, and to all we encounter in the world. "O Mary Immaculate, inflame our hearts with one ray of the burning love of thy pure heart." ## Blessed Karl's Corner -

As stated before, the whole Czernin, Clemenceau, letter incident (known as the Sixtus affair), greatly damaged Karl's reputation. But that wasn't all it did. As author Charles Coulombe writes, "The affair was a strong reminder of just how far apart the German and Austrian real needs and concerns were." Germany had nationalistic goals and ambitions, whereas Karl, Emperor over many peoples and countries followed Hapsburg tradition and thought in 'multi-national terms'. After the Sixtus affair, the 'Pan-Germans in Austria turned against the emperor; the German high command was resolved to snuff out any independence on the part of the dual monarchy; and Charles's (Karl) own cabinet ministers begged him to come to any possible arrangement with their more powerful ally'. Karl went to meet with the Kaiser and his generals on May 12.

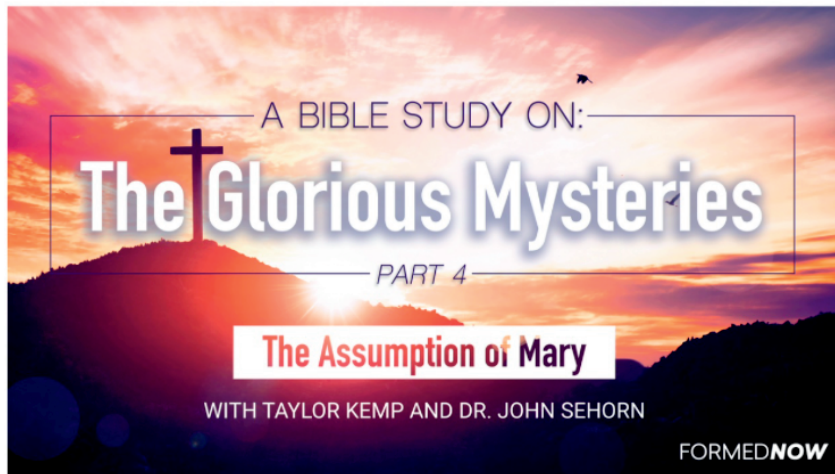
