## Padre's Pen - Sacred Scripture: Inspired and Inerrant

I thought it might be a good idea to offer a little lesson in this week's column on the Sacred Scriptures. Specifically, the Church's teaching on Divine inspiration and inerrancy and Catholic interpretation principles. The longstanding teaching of the Catholic Church affirmed by the Second Vatican Council is that the Sacred Scriptures are the inspired Word of God and are therefore inerrant (without error). The Constitution on Divine Revelation (*Dei Verbum*) from Vatican II presents the proper Catholic understanding of inspiration and inerrancy. In Short, God is the author of Sacred Scripture. The Sacred Scriptures are "... written under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, they have God as their author, and have been handed on as such to the Church herself." (DV, 11) Further, those that God chose to write the scriptures, "made full use of their powers and faculties so that, though he [God] acted in them and by them, it was as true authors that they consigned to writing whatever he [God] wanted to be written and no more." (DV,11) The same document goes on to state that the Sacred Scriptures "firmly, faithfully, and without error teach the truth which God, for the sake of our salvation, wished to see confided to sacred scripture." (DV,11)

**2 Timothy 3:16 states "All scripture is inspired by God..." Literally (from the Greek) this could be translated to "God-breathed." God did not just help the human authors or approve what they wrote, rather God inspired them from above as the principal author of the sacred scriptures, and the human writers are the instrumental authors. The human authors freely wrote the books of sacred scripture but wrote only that which God wanted.**

Because God is the principal author of Sacred Scripture, and God cannot err, it follows that the Sacred Scriptures are without error. The inerrancy of Sacred Scripture guarantees that all the events and writings presented to us in the Sacred Scriptures are unified, true, and accurately present salvation history to us (not as an encyclopedia of scientific fact, but rather as the author viewed and described the world according to their senses). It follows that the first sense in which Catholics read the Sacred Scriptures is the literal sense – that is, to read and understand the writings as the original authors and readers would have read and understood them in their particular settings (e.g., understanding that there are poems, letters, parables, and other figurative language). After the literal sense, we move on to the spiritual sense which includes three subdivisions of allegorical, moral, and tropological senses. There is far more on this subject than I can fit into a short column, I'm going to end here with the exhortation read through the Vatican II Constitution on Divine Revelation. When reading please look at the footnotes to see how the teaching of the Church on inspiration and inerrancy of the Sacred Scriptures remains consistent through the history of the Church to this day.

The end was near for the Hapsburg Empire, which had lasted since 1526, and Karl and Zita knew it. France had already recognized one of the empire's countries independently. Reinforced by the arrival of American troops, the Allies began their final offensive on August 8. Karl informed his German allies that his empire would not last much longer, certainly not to the end of the year. Again, he asked to sue for peace. Germany delayed. In September, Austria sent a separate request for an armistice to Wilson, but it was ignored. Bulgaria surrendered, opening up the southern front for Allied advancement. As things went from bad to worse, politicians in Vienna decided it was time to start listening to what their emperor thought should be done. Sadly, it was too late to save what was left of what was once called the Holy Roman Empire.

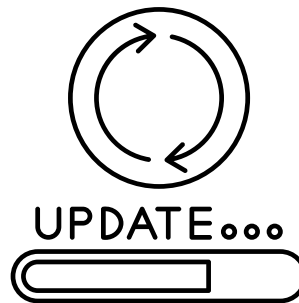


## Dear Parishioners, Parents, Grandparents, and Friends of SWS,
