Padre's Pen - Synod, Dozinky, & Tractor Blessings

Back in 2019, Archbishop Hebda began a process for the reevangelization of our Archdiocese. The process culminated in the Archdiocesan Synod on Pentecost weekend of 2022. We are now in the implementation phase of the Synod. Among all the recommendations received through the process, Archbishop Hebda chose a small group evangelization method known as the **Parish Evangelization Cell System (PECS)**. We are on the cusp of implementing this process in our parish.

As many of you heard a couple of weeks ago at Mass, we have 12 of our parishioners who make up our parish *Synod Evangelization Team (SET)*. Our SET has been working very hard and is "all in" on bringing the fullness of Christ to the life of our parish (we even got them golden t-shirts, so they can stand out in our parish). Many of you have already been approached and asked to take part in our next step forward. This weekend we are extending the invitation to all.

Beginning Tuesday, September 19, we are offering a seven-week formation series on establishing the PECS in our parish. I want to emphasize that attending these sessions in no way obligates you to be one of the leaders in the PECS program, but it does help you grow in your faith and understanding of Christ and His Church. It is worth your time and effort! Please take the time to speak to our SET members in the golden shirts after all our Masses this weekend.


