Padre's Pen – St. Michael Prayer, Feast Day, Marathon, Parish Offices

A few miscellaneous items of interest for you this week...

I want to remind everyone about the reason we added the St. Michael prayer at the end of our weekend Masses. We are one of the remote sites for the Catechetical Institute program. The patron for the 2-Year program in which we are participating is St. Michael the Archangel. Thus, in praying the St. Michael prayer we are both praying for the class that will graduate next spring as well as invoking the protection of this prince of the Angelic Choirs for protection on our parish.

Also, remember that our parish Solemn Feast Day is September 28. In the order of liturgical precedence, the name/patronal feast day for a parish church is among the highest feast days for that church. That means the Feast of St. Wenceslaus is up there with Christmas, Easter, and the high feast days of our Lord and our Lady. Therefore, we move our School Mass day to Thursday, September 28, and we celebrate the Mass with the full complement of music, the Gloria, the Creed, and readings from the Old Testament, New Testament, and Gospels.

With the Feast of St. Wenceslaus on September 28, it should be a reminder to all of us that it is also the School Marathon. This is one of the biggest fundraisers for our great school. I have not yet surpassed Ron McBroom in fundraising. Maybe this year will be the year. Or maybe, between Fr. Gifford and myself we can together surpass Ron in fundraising. In other words, both Fr. Gifford and myself appreciate any donations you make to our fundraising efforts for the school.

Blessed Karl's Corner -

As the terrible war began to show signs of coming to an end, Karl began looking towards the future. Once there would no longer be the concern of war and trying to find peace, he would, at last, be able to concentrate on his empire. October 1918, seeing, at last, that they were not going to win, the German generals demanded that a request for peace be made to the Allies. On October 4, both Austria and Germany sent Wilson messages looking for peace. In Austria's note, they outlined the reforms hoped for by the Empire and requested time to restructure things. No response came. On October 16, Karl issued his "Imperial Manifesto", which stated his desire to recognize and give voices and homes to the various nationalities living within his empire. Hungary was its own separate issue and Karl was careful that the dealings in Austria would not affect 'the integrity of the lands of the holy Hungarian crown.'

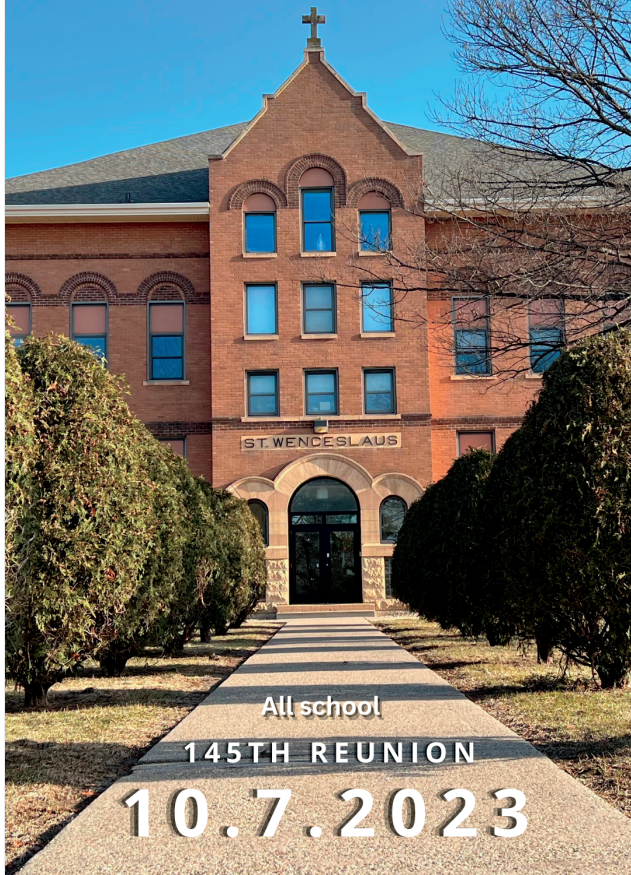
