## Padre's Pen – Archangels and Angels

As I mentioned last week, our Patronal Feast of St. Wenceslaus is this week, September 28. It is a day to storm heaven for the good of our parish, people, and area. Also, don't forget to support our school with the school marathon on Saturday morning. This is one of the major fundraisers for our school and helps us make our budgets. Immediately following our Patronal Feast is another major Feast. On Friday, September 29, we celebrate the Feast of Saints Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael Archangels (not to forget the Feast of our Guardian Angels on October 2). The Lord in His great mercy has given us the protection and help of these purely spiritual creatures. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us that "From its beginning until death, human life is surrounded by their watchful care and intercession." (CCC 336). St. Augustine tells us that "Angel" is the name of their office, not of their nature. Their nature is spiritual.

In the case of the Archangels whose names we know, Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael, their names give us some insight as to their nature or mission in the order of creation. Michael whose name means "Who is like unto God" is the great leader of the hosts of God's creatures protecting God's people from the fallen angels. Gabriel whose name means "Power of God" is the great messenger of the Incarnation and the Holy Spirit's power to bring us salvation. Raphael whose name means "God heals" can bring us great solace in times of physical ailments and protection from demonic activity (read through the Book of Tobit to see this powerful Archangel's mission). Put these three Archangels together with our own assigned Guardian Angel and we can be sure of the spiritual assistance we need in these very troubled times.

**Saint Wenceslaus Pray for Us!**  
**The Feast of St. Wenceslaus is September 28.**

Since we are surrounded by these heavenly helpers, I recommend that we take advantage of their presence. Pray the "Saint Michael the Archangel" prayer daily. Greet and speak/pray to your Guardian Angel. Ask Gabriel the Archangel to announce the power of the Holy Spirit in your lives. Plead for Raphael the Archangel to accompany and protect you in life's journey as he did for Tobiah in the Sacred Scriptures. Don't let a day go by without interacting with these great protectors and intercessors.

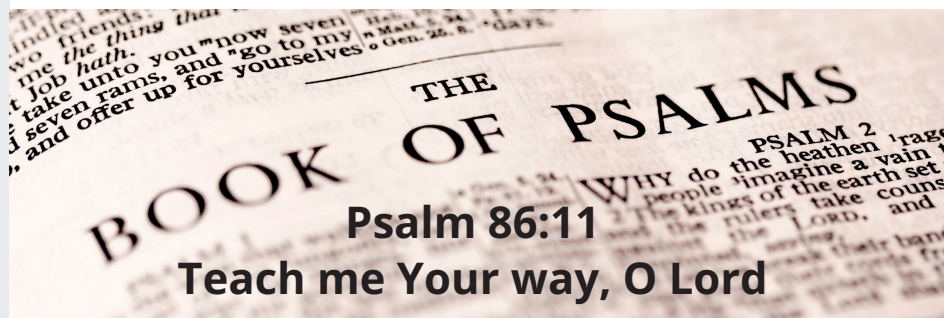


## Kitchen Volunteers.
