Padre's Pen – I Didn't Know!

I was teaching one of the middle school religion classes the other day and one of the kids asked me what I do all day. I had to chuckle a little bit in my head because that is one of the questions that I get the most frequently. What does a priest do all day? Don't you just say Mass and sit around waiting for people to die so you can give them the last rights? If only my day was so open. So, I told the class what my typical day looks like and what my typical week looks like. The most important part of my day is prayer. I will have the parish rosary and Mass as well as the Liturgy of the Hours and my holy hour. Without this check-in with God and our parishioners, life as a priest would be insufferable. My typical day also includes an informal check-in with Fr. Theisen, and other staff as needed. I typically go to guest teach in one of the school classrooms three times a week and have evening meetings for faith formation, sacramental prep, etc. several times a week. Usually, there is an anointing, funeral, or baptism thrown in there as well.

However, one thing that is a little different for me here at St. Wenceslaus is that I am only part-time. Most priests, like Fr. Theisen are full-time in the parish. I, on the other hand, am also a student. The diocese is having me study canon law and I plan to graduate with the degree in August 2025. Thus, my daily life looks slightly different than the normal priest, who does everything above and more. Instead of things like parish council meetings, I have classes that I attend online three times a week (currently Advanced Latin in Canonical Literature and Supra-Diocesan Structures). Even on my one day off a week at St. Wenceslaus, I still have class. So that means not only attending class, but I have homework as well, including extensive readings in canon law and writing papers. However, most of my homework time is taken up by translating documents from Latin, Italian, German, and French.

These translations are not only for my classes but also for my thesis. Archbishop Hebda asked that as part of my assignment down here in New Prague, I work on my thesis in order to graduate on time. Our Chancellor, Susan Mulheron, asked that I write on a new canon that Pope Francis added to the Code of Canon Law a few years ago. So, I spend a good chunk of time each week, (even sometimes while I watch football) working on my thesis. I am making good progress with currently 28 pages in with 60 pages being the goal. So, when that middle schooler asked me what I do all day, and I chuckled to myself, I explained, and she said, "I didn't know."

Also, we welcome all Veterans, whom we celebrate at our Sunday 8:30 am Mass. Thank you for your sacrifice and service.
