

The purpose of the Confirmation Program at St. Wenceslaus is to provide an opportunity for the youth of the parish to grow in their relationship with Jesus and increase their knowledge and understanding of the Catholic Christian Faith. During this process, the youth will be prepared to receive the Gift of the Holy Spirit through the Sacrament of Confirmation. We do this in a community atmosphere, as well as via individual spiritual growth. Our desire is to actively engage the students in a dynamic learning environment.



WHAT TO EXPECT AT ST. WENCESLAUS CONFIRMATION

What will Confirmation look like this year? We know you have probably heard this from many people, but here are a few points we want to cover.



Drop off and pick up will be at the Parish Activities Center (PAC) doors.



We will serve a light breakfast to the Sunday Confirmation students. Please alert us to allergies.



Confirmation Sundays run 8:45 am - 11:30 am, which includes 10:30 Mass.



Prayer is an essential component to our life of faith, and we encourage you to pray and grow together.



We will communicate via Flocknote and the Remind app. Please also see the bulletin, facebook, and instagram pages for updates.



Time with the Lord is essential to preparation for Confirmation. There is a Mandatory Retreat. Dates can be found on Calendar.



Mass attendance is an obligation of the Catholic Faith and our program.



Community service is a mandatory component for Confirmation. A minimum of 10 hours for community and 10 hours for the parish is expected.



Confirmation Requirements

8th Grade Confirmation St. Wenceslaus School Families (Option B)

Your child will receive formation in their religion class and will not be attending the Confirmation sessions listed in the schedule (next page); however, they are expected to be at the following: Parent Meeting, Lifeline Mass, Sponsor Events, and the Purified Event. St Wenceslaus Confirmation students are required to fulfill all Confirmation and Youth Ministry requirements, as listed on page six. Youth Ministry events are parishplanned and sanctioned events. School students must also fulfill the mandatory 20 hours of community service, 10 in the community, and 10 for St. Wenceslaus Parish. School-sanctioned events can count toward community service hours.

8th and 9th Grade Sunday Confirmation (Option A)

Youth are to be dropped off by 8:40 am in front of the Parish Activities Center (PAC). Youth will be dismissed after the 10:30 Mass and will be picked up in the PAC lot. Makeup classes will be held the following Wednesday during Faith Formation from 6:30-8pm. Confirmation students will also complete the Personal Safety Lesson program as mandated by the Archdiocese and denoted on schedule as PSL.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL CONFIRMATION STUDENTS (Option A & Option B)

- Weekly attendance at Confirmation and/or Religion class and regular Mass attendance
- Sponsor Eligibility Certificate
- Sponsor interview
- Confirmation Retreat: One for 8th grade students, (school students will attend the SWS retreat or another approved retreat). 9th grade will attend two retreats.
- Sponsor Meeting: If the sponsor cannot be present, a parent will be required to attend.
- Saint Report
- 20 hours of service each year, half of which needs to be done in association with St. Wenceslaus Parish.
- Youth will participate in two Youth Ministry events per year
- Purified event, eighth-grade parents are encouraged to be in attendance
- At least one parent from each family must assist in two parish-sanctioned Youth Ministry or service project events a year.

Student Behavior:

 Prayerful, respectable behavior is expected of youth, catechists, and parents in the Church and program rooms. Parents are expected to show a proper example to their teens.
 Remember that Church is God's House and is not to be treated like a gymnasium.

- The use of tobacco products is not permitted by anyone on campus.
- Vandalism of any type will not be tolerated.
- Fighting and physical contact between students is prohibited in and on the church property.

 No running in the building or immediately outside, unless the activity is led by a Catechist.

Attendance Policy:

- We support the family in its effort to form their children and youth in the faith. We believe that the home is the best and most privileged place to share our faith, since it is lived there on a daily basis. Parents are the primary catechists of their children.
- Regular attendance at Confirmation sessions is CRITICAL in order to provide the best faith formation possible. However, we do understand that some absences are unavoidable due to illnesses or family emergencies.
- Call/email Faith Formation staff for any anticipated absence for your child. If a student is absent without an excuse for 2 consecutive weeks, parents will be contacted by phone by Faith Formation Staff.
- Your child will be expected to attend the following Wednesday night 6:30pm-8pm for the makeup lessons.
- The parents of students who are perpetually late to class or leave early will be contacted by Faith Formation Staff for resolution. These practices put an unfair burden on the catechists and other students.
