Electing a new Pope

On May 7, 2025, the Cardinal electors entered the Sistine Chapel to begin the conclave to elect the next pope. The gathering began with

a "Mass for the Election of the Roman Pontiff" in St. Peter's Basilica that morning after which the Cardinals proceeded in a solemn procession to the Sistine chapel. Each Cardinal elector takes an oath of secrecy and commits, if elected, to faithfully fulfill the Petrine Ministry as Pastor of the Universal Church.

There are currently 135 cardinals eligible to vote for the next pope, but at least two of them will not be present due to personal reasons. To validly elect a new Pope, a two-thirds majority of the electors present is required. If voting begins on the afternoon of the first day, there is only one ballot; on subsequent days, two ballots will be held in the morning and two in the afternoon.

Once votes are counted, all ballots are burned. If the ballot is inconclusive, the chimney positioned over the Sistine Chapel emits black smoke. When a cardinal receives the necessary votes, he is asked if he accepts his election. If he accepts, he chooses a papal name and is dressed in papal vestments before processing out to the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica. The ballots from the final round are burned with chemicals producing white smoke to signal to the world the election of a new pope.

The senior cardinal deacon announces from the balcony of St. Peter's "*Habemus Papam*" - "We have a pope" before the new pope processes out and imparts his blessing on the city of Rome and the entire world.


