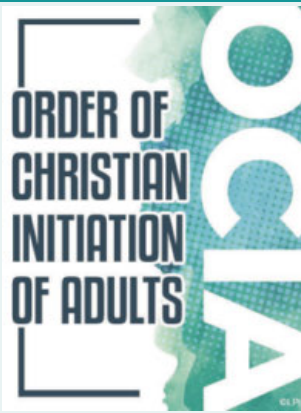

OCIA is a learning process in which conversion of the heart brings one to Jesus Christ. It is a spiritual journey that varies according to time, place, and individual needs.

It primarily focuses on:

Faith development (rather than mastery of doctrine) and maturing in one's relationship with God.

Building and nourishing relationships, not only among the participants and leaders but within the parish community and the universal church.

It is an answer to the Gospel invitation in Mathew 11:28-30: "Come to me, all you who are weary and find life burdensome, and I will refresh you. Take my yoke upon your shoulders and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble of heart. Your souls will find rest, for my yoke is easy and my burden light."

OCIA is an opportunity

-- For those who have not been baptized.

-- For those who have been baptized, but have little affiliation with, and/or training in the Catholic religion.

-- For those who want to learn and ask questions about the Catholic faith.

Through weekly gatherings, those attending gain a deeper appreciation and understanding of the Catholic beliefs and practices. All are welcome, and there is no obligation to make any commitment to become Catholic.

There will be an Orientation on Wednesday, August 20th at 6:30 pm in the Church sanctuary. Sessions begin on Sunday, August 24th after the 8:00 a.m. Mass. We meet in the school cafeteria and sessions usually run from 9:15 to 11:15 a.m.

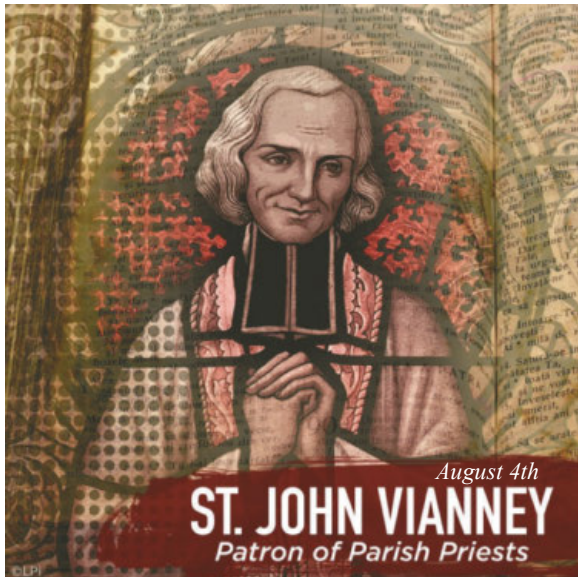

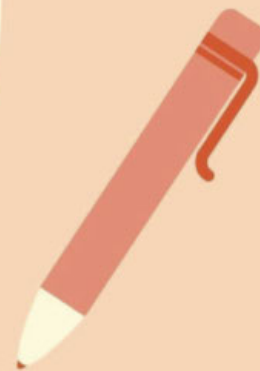

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

August 3, 2025
18th Sunday in Ordinary Time
Luke 12:13-21

Recent studies suggest that millennials will be the first generation in America to be worse off than their parents in terms of financial earnings and job status. Many lament this. I propose that this week's Gospel provides a hopeful way to see the trend as good news.

The Lord Jesus says, "Take care to guard against greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist in possessions" (Luke 12:15). Greed damages us with the deception that we are what we possess. But to Jesus, this is simply not true. What makes us happy is who we are, who we become.

Does not the expectation that every generation should do better than their parents subtly mask the poison of greed? A similar attitude is mirrored in the man who demands that Jesus justly arrange his share of the family inheritance. Despite the injustice, Jesus will not play that game. In fact, he seems to prefer that the man have less than his parents. What good would having more be to this man if he becomes enslaved and miserable by greed? What good would it be for us to have more if it means we become much less?

In allowing the man to have less, Jesus opens a space for him to become more: a man free to love. In that much more meaningful sense, perhaps he was better off than his parents. Maybe the millennials will be, too.

Why SAD in Summer?



- **Temperature:** High temperatures can cause uncomfortable physical symptoms and irritability.
- **Light:** People with summer SAD may find this time difficult to sleep, to stay on task, or it may influence their sleep and eating rhythms.
- **Allergies:** Allergies lead to anxiety, irritability, and unwanted physical symptoms that can last months.
- **Disrupted Routines & Schedules:** Busy weeks and disrupted routines can be stressful, as it means disorganization and a lack of control over day to day life.
- **Vacation Envy:** When we see others enjoying the freedom to travel, we compare ourselves and envy what others have.
- **Financial Concerns:** Summer months can be very expensive for some people. With increased activities, money can be tight.
- **Body Image Issues:** When temperature rises, clothes come off. Having to show more skin can be anxiety provoking and stressful.

Summer Seasonal Affective Disorder (SAD)

Seasonal Affective Disorder is often thought of as a winter disorder. However, SAD is a disorder that affects a person's mood in a seasonal pattern; this pattern does not necessarily have to be associated with dark, cold, wintery months.

Although Summer SAD is not widely studied, it is estimated that approximately 10 percent of all people with SAD experience it in summer months. For most people, when summer comes it is a happy season full of fun and growth.

However, for some, summer can mean an increase in depressive symptoms. It is important to recognize your symptoms before they get worse. Symptoms become an issue when you feel that they are severe enough to cause difficulty or impairment in your ability to function at home, at school or work, or within relationships.

If your mental and physical state is affecting your daily living, you should see a mental health professional or your family doctor.

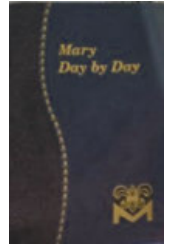

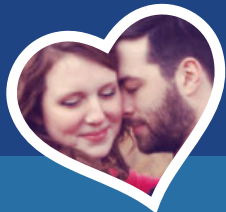
