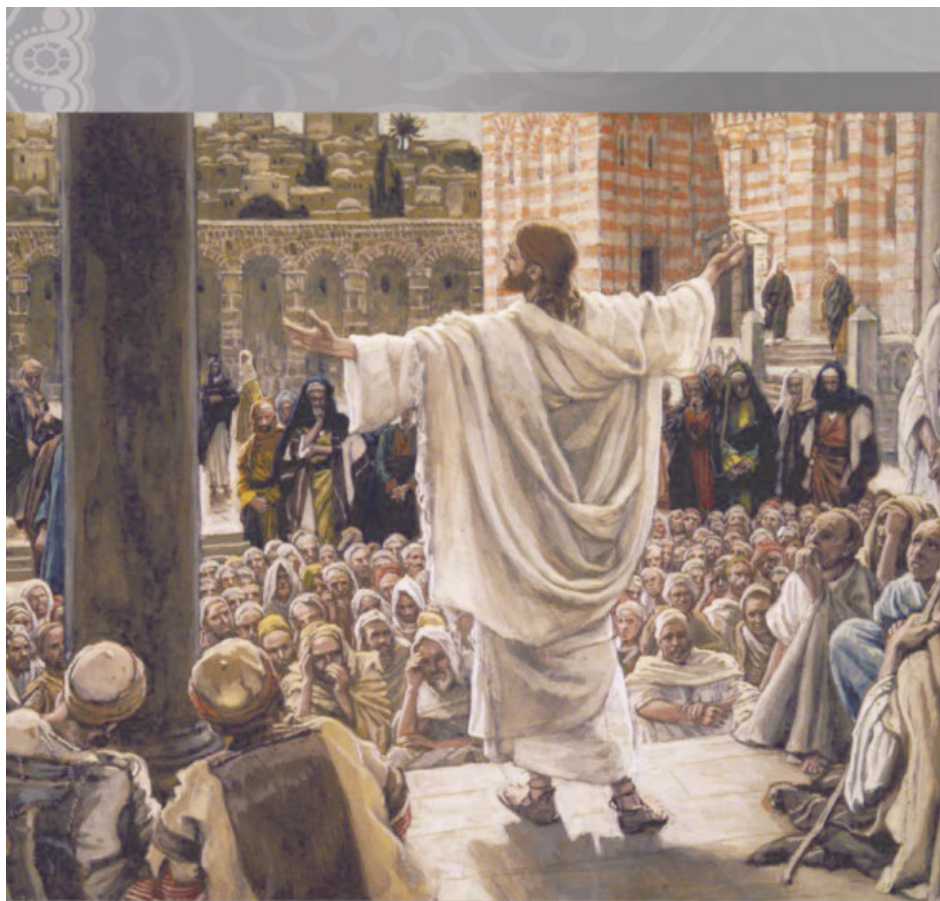

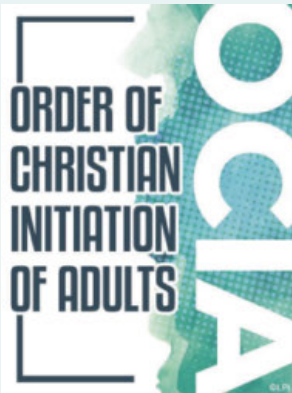

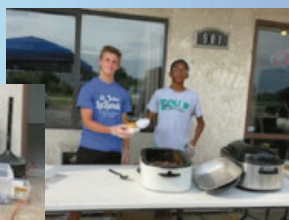

Two-minute TOB



A quick re-cap of the last Two-Minute TOB:

JPII: "...the [human] body, and only the body, is capable of making visible what is invisible: the spiritual and the divine"

Sharing a meal with another person provides a concrete example of the invisible being made visible

JPII goes on to say in that very same quotation that "...the body has been created to transfer into the visible reality of the world the mystery hidden for eternity in God, and thus to be a sign of it." What is that mystery? In short:

That God exists, and He created the universe.

That God made humanity in his image, male and female (Gen 1:24).

God loves us so much that he invites us to be 'co-creators' with him through our bodies!

How amazing is that?!? All of creation sprang forth from God's love. His love couldn't be contained and...BAM!...the universe came into being. Mental Health Ministry



Back to School & Mental Health

The start of a new school year may be exciting for some kids but can often bring feelings of stress and anxiety for others. This may be especially true for young girls. According to a study by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), young girls in the United States said they felt persistently sad or hopeless at double the rate of boys. Issues around social media use may exacerbate these issues — one study states teens that spend more than three hours a day on social media platforms may face twice the risk of mental health issues.

How do you gauge how your child is feeling?

Keep an eye on their behaviors and moods. A check-in with their doctor may also be helpful. “You may think of your child’s annual checkup for things like vaccines, but it’s also a good place to check in on their mental health, says Dr. Rhonda Randall, chief medical officer at United Healthcare. Make sure your child knows they can come to you anytime with questions or to share their feelings. If they do talk about being scared or nervous, validate their feelings. Listen intently and avoid asking too many questions. Help them feel secure and let them know it’s possible to feel better.

“Remember these can be sensitive topics for your child,” Dr. Randall said. “Empathy, openness and patience can go a long way in helping them feel heard and optimistic that they’ll be OK.”

Your student may be watching how you are preparing for the school year, so model good behavior. Make this a “do as I do” moment. Eat right, exercise and get the sleep you need to stay positive, even during hectic times...coping with stress in a healthy way can boost resilience.

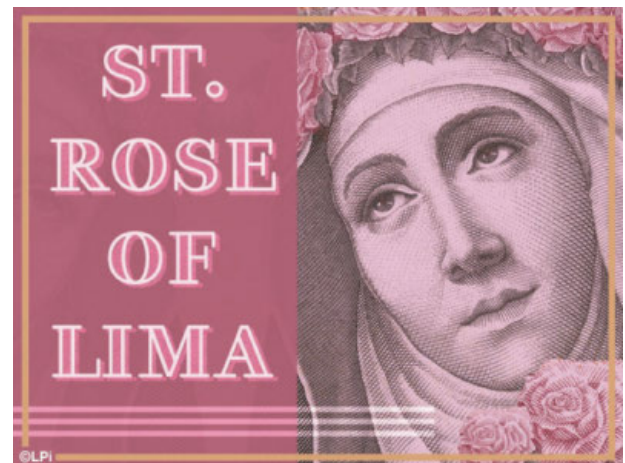

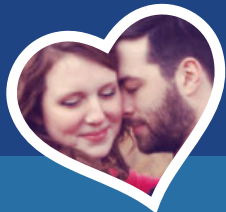
