

Pastor's Page

CHRISTMAS - FIRST HIS GIFT . . . THEN OURS

First it was His gift . . . to us. Our Father sent us His Son as the first Christmas gift on that first Christmas. And it is divinely fitting that the "Christmas story" is the most beautiful story in the world's history. How could the coming of God into our world be anything less than that? The way He came . . . the Virgin with Child, the flummoxed betrothed who became the Guardian of the Redeemer, the journey to Bethlehem, the "no room at the inn", the manger, the angels, the shepherds, the star, the Kings . . . if it was fiction no one would have thought up that plot line. But as usual, with God, HE thought it up - and so it's very real.

Now we have our chance on His birthday each year to give gifts, too. And since, as He tells us, that whatever we do for each other, we are also doing for Him, it is our way of giving a gift to Him as well as to the intended recipient. That's why the best gifts are given freely, and have some love behind them. He gave us our freedom so that we could give, and He gave us a share in His own love so that we could have some of that to include in our gifts, and so our Christmas gifts mean most which have them.

Our parish family also has a chance to "give" - and we did again this year with our Advent Giving Trees and our response to the needs on them. Here's what our parish family offered to the Women's Care Center, the St. Gianna's Maternity Home, the St Michael and Ft. Totten Indian Missions, the Dorothy Day House, the Churches United for the Homeless, and our own parish outreach to those who ask us right here for assistance:

- 759 ornaments were returned of the 800 we put on the trees
- 670 gifts
- 75 packages of diapers
- \$7,530 in gift cards
- \$950 for the Women's Care Center
- \$2,580 for St. Michael's/Ft. Totten
- \$1,870 for St. Gianna's
- \$2,130 for our parish outreach

This past week I received a card from St. Gianna's and here's part of what was written:

"Once again we are overwhelmed by the generosity of all at your parish. . . . These gifts will be used to help both current and former residents who are struggling right now. It is only because of people like you that we are able to help so many. Year after year we are blessed by your gifts and prayers . . . Thank you for helping us continue in our mission of "one mother, one baby, one family at a time" in the spirit of St. Gianna."

It's fun - and meaningful - and graced - to give gifts at this time of the year, isn't it? And all of you have gifted me with such a fine, blessed parish to pastor! Have a Merry Christmas - and a blessed New Year!
