## Pastor's Page

### A LAY MISSIONARY & A SEMINARIAN

"The harvest is great but the laborers are few." Our Lord Jesus said that once, and He followed it up by asking us to pray for those needed laborers in the harvest of humanity for God our Father that He won for us by His life and death. Here are two men who have answered the Lord's call to serve Him in the life of the Church.

Thomas Hollcraft is a member of our parish who is on his second stint as a lay missionary with NET Ministries out of the Twin Cities. He received much support from our parish family this past summer, and he wanted to share with all of us what has been happening with him and how things are going.

*Hello all!*

*You may not remember me, but my name is Thomas Hollcraft and I spoke to the parish in August about my year serving with NET ministries. So many of you were incredibly generous and helped my mission by donating to my year. I want to give you an update on how I've been since then. Over the last few months I have been on a team of 10 young people between the ages of 18 and 24 going around the country leading retreats for middle schoolers and high schoolers. Whether it's been confirmation retreats for just 15 kids, or school retreats for over 100 of them, the Lord has been working through these retreats so much. Not only have I been able to see God work through our retreats, I also am able to see him work through my team mates every single day. Over the course of the year my team becomes like my family and it has been such a blessing to see them grow throughout the semester and they have helped me personally to grow in my faith so much. I have been praying for you all every day and will continue to do so as the year continues. Any extra prayers you can spare always appreciated and I hope you all have a very blessed Christmas and new year! Thomas Hollcraft*

As most of you know, Fr. Kyle Metzger resides "in-residence" at our parish rectory. You will often see him at parish Masses on the weekends. He is the principal of Shanley High School and is also the Vocation Director for the diocese. He often requests that our parish open its doors to seminarians when they are required to do some parish internship time as part of their seminarian formation. This January is no exception. Justin Reineke is a first-year theologian at St. Paul Seminary in St. Paul, MN, and his formation program requires a couple of weeks during their "J-term" living in a parish and learning about parish and diocesan life. Justin will be at our parish from January 3-16. He will be present at most of the week day and Sunday Masses. Welcome him - and pray for him and all our seminarians. We need good men of God to shepherd us in our parishes in the years to come!



*My name is Justin Reineke, and I was born the ninth of twelve children (seven boys and five girls) in Fargo, North Dakota. I first received a desire for the Priesthood from attending daily Mass at a young age and from the holy example of the deceased Father Peter Hughes, a former rector of the Cathedral. I was deeply inspired by his reverence for the Eucharist, the wonderful joy he had in greeting people and the way that everyone became happy and joyful whenever they spoke to him. After my Confirmation and First Holy Communion, I began to serve Daily Mass along with my younger brothers. In my senior year of High School, I began to meet with a spiritual director on a regular basis. With my spiritual director's guidance, I decided to discern the possibility of a Religious vocation with the Franciscan of Mary Immaculate, with whom I stayed for nearly five years. Towards the end of my fifth year with the Franciscans, I took part in a thirty-day Ignatian retreat. From this retreat, I discerned that God has not called me to the Religious life, and so I left the Franciscans. I then requested from Bishop Folda to study for the Diocese of Fargo, as I still feel a deep and firm call to the Priesthood. I graduated from St. Gregory the Great minor seminary in Seward, NE on May 8, 2021, and just began my*

first year of Theology studies at St. Paul Seminary this past September 1. My preferred hobbies are reading and hiking with a small admixture of writing, drawing, painting, and linguistics. I now continue to pursue the priestly vocation through my seminary studies, with a deep and ardent desire to bring praise to God, honor to the Virgin Mary, and salvation, peace, and joy to all souls.

It is a fine tribute to the blessings of our parish family that we have men that come out of this parish to serve the Lord and His Church - in this case, Thomas - and that we have men that are sent here by the Bishop and the Vocation Director to dig in and get good experience in ministering and learning how to minister to the People of God in and through the Church - in this case, Justin.

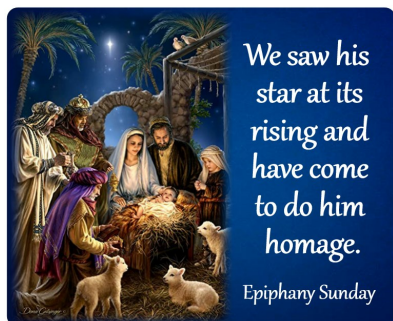
