






McChoir's Music Corner

"Nothing Ordinary Here"

It's the 20th week in Ordinary Time, and if I am being honest, Ordinary Time feels monotonous after a while. The liturgical seasons give us something refreshing to pray & worship with every year. Ordinary Time is no different in that regard. The difference is that it is the longest season (we're not done with Ordinary Time until November!). How do we reset ourselves to keep our focus where it ought to be? That answer is different for individuals, but it's a good question for all of us. The liturgy is a humbling ceremony of worship; we have to do what St. John the Baptist says in regard to the coming of Jesus: "He must increase, but I must decrease." (John 3:30) Our closing hymn today is "Be Thou My Vision," let's start answering the question of how to reset ourselves and get our focus on Christ, keeping him as our vision as we worship.
