





# McChoir's Music Corner

#### "A Metrical Paraphrase"

You might be surprised to know how many hymns fit into a category of what we call, "metrical paraphrases," which are essentially songs that have a rhymed translation of a scriptural text. This is the case for our opening today. If you look at the fine print underneath *O God Our Help in Ages Past*, it says, "based on Psalm 90:1-5." Isaac Watts took the text of Psalm 90, and created a poem text that could be used with simple music. It is a nice fit for this liturgy because our responsorial psalm today is also Psalm 90. My background is in education, and one of the important facets of a comprehensive education, is to diversify exposure when teaching. This is a fancy way of saying that we present the same material in different ways to aid in comprehension. It's always worth a look in your hymnal to see where a text comes from. Take

a look at some of your favorite hymns and see what the origin of the text is, you just might

end up with a new favorite scripture passage!
