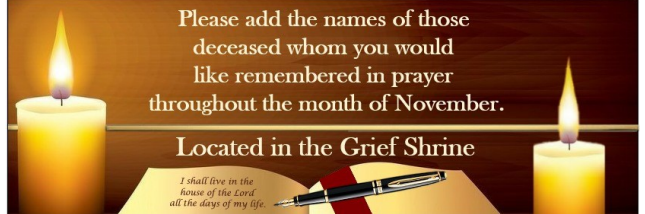

## McChoir's Music Corner

### "Every Knee Shall Bow"

The name of Jesus Christ is "above all names," (Phil 2:9) and as we sang in the psalm today, "I will praise your name forever, my king and my God." That name demands some reverence from us, so now is a fitting time to introduce a new hymn: "At the Name of Jesus," which we sang for offertory today. I try to do a good job myself of praying with texts and aligning the music we sing to the message of each liturgy we celebrate, and this text is a beautiful testament to the power of Jesus' name. I am particularly fond of verse 4 when we sing, "let his will enfold you in its light and power." God is above all, we know that, but do we acknowledge that in our hearts? Knowing something is not the same as believing or even living it. Jesus Christ is the King of kings, Lord of lords, he is enthroned forever; (which we celebrate in a special way coming up soon!) but do we give him a throne in our own hearts? Does our knee bend at the name of Jesus? These are good things to ponder as we head into the end of the liturgical year.

## STEWARDSHIP MOMENT

*"But Zacchaeus stood there and said to the Lord, 'Behold, half of my possessions, Lord, I will give to the poor, and if I extorted anything from anyone I shall repay it four times over.'" - LUKE 19:8*

We are all called to gratefully give back to the Lord in proportion to the gifts we have been given. This means not everyone is called to give the same amount, but everyone is called to give equal sacrifice. Open your heart and talk to God about how you use your money. How is God calling you to be more generous with your financial resources and possessions?
