

McChoir's Music Corner

3rd Sunday of Advent

"A Happy Carol of Hope"

You might be reading this after singing our recessional hymn asking, "what was that?" Yes, this is a new selection to us this year, but it is certainly not 'new.' "O Come, Divine Messiah" is a French Carol from the 16th century, with the current melody written sometime later in the 17th century or so. This tune, like many other old carols around Christmastime, were likely folk tunes of some sort before being associated with Christmas. St Francis of Assisi is credited with introducing Christmas Carols into church services as a way to help teach about the birth of Christ. There is a very positive affirmation of hope in this carol, while still acknowledging "the night," and our "sadness," that we hope will be lifted away with the coming of Christ. Our Advent anticipation continues to grow, and with it, our excitement, for the Messiah to come.
