Sacraments and Parish Nursing







Merry Christmas! It is high time for many of our favorites to be sung exuberantly! "Silent Night," "Joy to the World," "O Come All Ye Faithful," "Angels We Have Heard on High," and many, many, more. I hope you enjoy singing the music of this season with great joy. It's no surprise that on this happy occasion, music seems such an integral part of the celebration we enjoy together in our homes and communities. Take a moment to think about music: it does nothing for our 'survival' as human beings; it doesn't feed us, give us rest, hydrate us, or any of those essential 'needs' of life.
