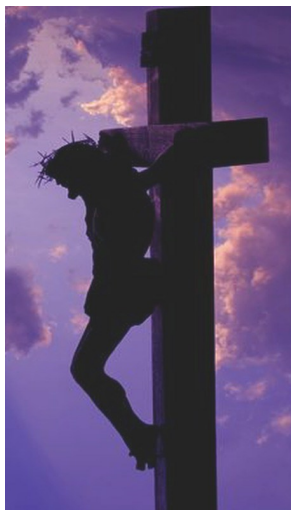

Sacraments and Parish Nursing

Sacrament of Baptism: Please call the church for scheduling. Attendance at a baptism class should be within the last two months before the birth of the child. You must be a registered member of the parish. Parents are required to attend a class for each child.

Sacrament of Marriage: Visit our website to view our wedding policy for details on marriage preparation and wedding details. Our wedding coordinator at the parish office must be contacted at least seven months in advance of a wedding date.

Communion to Shut-ins: Please call the office to receive communion or a pastoral visit for the homebound.

Anointing of the Sick: Anyone having surgery or wishing to receive this sacrament is asked to call either the office or the rectory. Please notify the pastor upon admission of a family member to the hospital.

## McChoir's *Music* Corner

In our readings for Mass today, we see that God loves us so dearly "that while we were still sinners Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8, Second Reading) God is no doubt merciful, to save us despite our sins. So we sang *There's a Wideness in God's Mercy* as we reflected on the readings. And still, at communion we sang "Have mercy on us, Lord, Jesus our savior: burdened with sin, we implore you." This is not wallowing in self-pity, but a healthy recognition of our need to call out to Christ. We need Him. Our Catechism tells us that "Christ died for all men without exception." (CCC 402) The Samaritan woman in the Gospel today must have felt shame & embarrassment when Jesus told her what her sins were, but Jesus' clarity allowed her to see herself as who she truly is: both loved by God and in need of conversion. She was so moved by this encounter that she bought others to Christ. In verse 4 of our communion hymn we sing, "O gentle Savior, great is your compassion." We, like the Samaritan woman, can use the recognition of our faults not as an attack on our person, but as a reminder of our need to depend on Jesus, our 'gentle Savior.' That sounds like someone I want to bring my friends & family to, don't you?

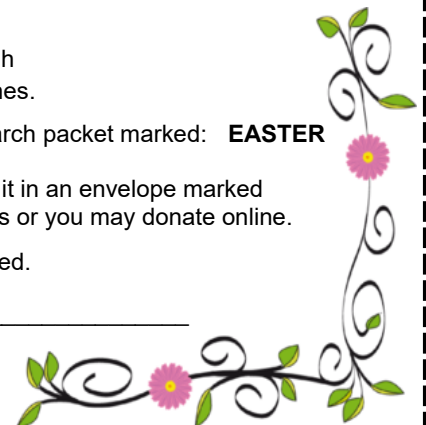

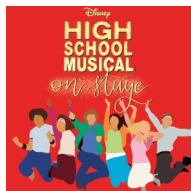

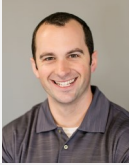
