McChoir's Music Corner

In our readings for Mass today, we see that God loves us so dearly "that while we were still sinners Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8, Second Reading) God is no doubt merciful, to save us despite our sins. So we sang There's a Wideness in God's Mercy as we reflected on the readings. And still, at communion we sang "Have mercy on us, Lord, Jesus our savior: burdened with sin, we implore you." This is not wallowing in self-pity, but a healthy recognition of our need to call out to Christ. We need Him. Our Catechism tells us that "Christ died for all men without exception." (CCC 402) The Samaritan woman in the Gospel today must have felt shame & embarrassment when Jesus told her what her sins were, but Jesus' clarity allowed her to see herself as who she truly is: both loved by God and in need of conversion. She was so moved by this encounter that she bought others to Christ. In verse 4 of our communion hymn we sing, "O gentle Savior, great is your compassion." We, like the Samaritan woman, can use the recognition of our faults not as an attack on our person, but as a reminder of our need to depend on Jesus, our 'gentle Savior.' That sounds like someone I want to bring my friends & family to, don't you?




