

McChoir's Music Corner

We've introduced some new hymns during this Easter season, and I am really glad we're doing that! Our entrance hymn today is a classic in the hymn repertoire: "Hail Thee Festival Day!" It's a great tune written by one of the most famous 20th century composers, Ralph Vaughan Williams. His musical setting pairs well with the text originally written sometime in the 6th century by Venantius Honorius Fortunatus. One thing I particularly like about this hymn in its context today is the first verse where we sing, "All the fair beauty of earth, from the death of the winter arising!" We're (as I write this a couple of weeks out) finally on our way out from the snow and cold, and welcoming warmer temperatures in a long-awaited spring. The Easter season has an air of renewal to it, as we are reminded of our baptismal promises on Easter weekend, and then sprinkled with holy water again each week and reminded of our new life in Christ.






