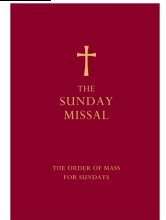

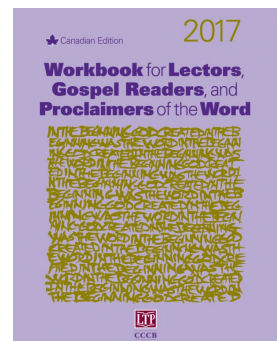

## The Book of Remembrance

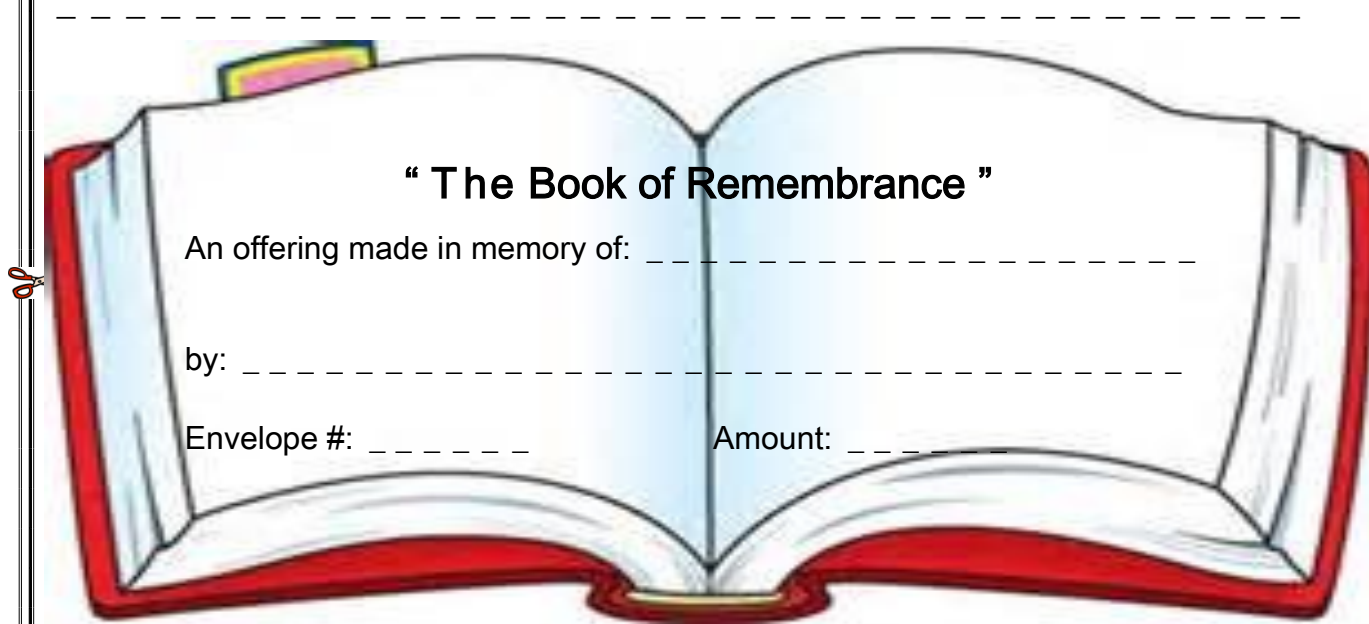
Traditionally, during the month of November, we particularly pray for the “holy souls”, those faithful Christians who have died and gone before us.
