STEWARDSHIP

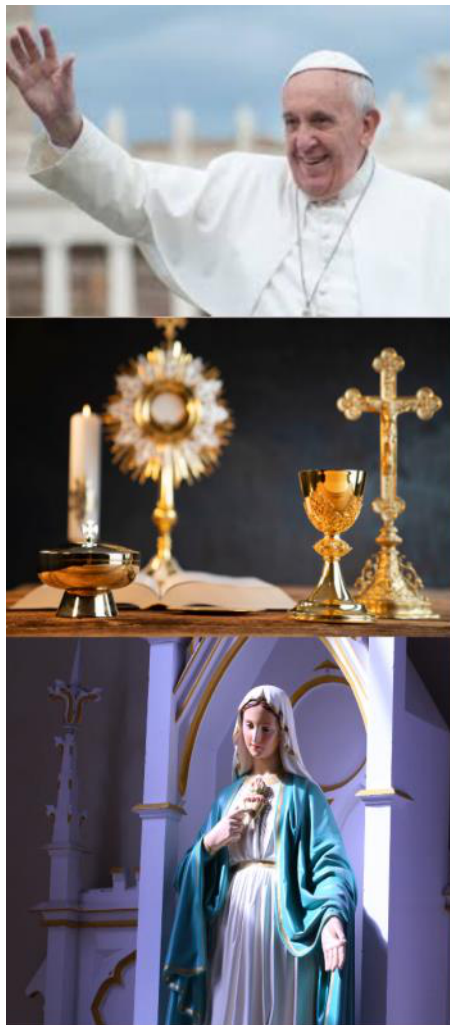
PARAMETERS

3. What is the intension of your tithing your time, talent and treasure to the parish? Is it done out of a sense of gratitude to God or based upon what you receive in return (buildings, lights, Sacraments, etc.? How are the two different and how might tithing from gratitude change your relationship with God?
4. What does it mean to say that we have a welcoming Family of Parishes? What does this look like concretely? How can you contribute to the welcoming atmosphere each time you attend Mass, meetings, sporting events, etc.?
