## From the Desk of Father Mason

Congratulations to our students confirmed this weekend by Bishop DeGrood.

This Monday is Martin Luther King Day and I always enjoy re-reading his letter from the Birmingham jail. It is based on classical theology and philosophy and the natural law – something many of his modern “claimed” followers would adamantly deny. I would encourage you to read the letter (it’s on-line), some time this week to aid all of us in continually growing in the life of the Spirit. I offer an encouragement from Servant of God Luis Maria Martinez and a prayer from Cardinal Mercier.

“When a temple is consecrated to God it is a place set apart for Him alone. The greatest possible purity and solidity, the truest art, are used in its construction; and after it is magnificently ornamented, it is offered to God, to be His forever. Now, the Scriptures tell us very plainly that we are temples of the Holy Spirit. Saint Paul says, *Do you know now that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?*

Every Christian is a temple of the Holy Spirit; every Christian is consecrated to Him. Nothing else may be done in that temple in which God dwells except that which will give glory to Him. Saint Paul taught that even the most ordinary actions of the Christian should be done to this end: *Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or do anything else, do all for the glory of God.*

True devotion to the Holy Spirit, therefore, is not something superficial and intermittent, but something profound and constant, like the Christian life itself. It is the love of the soul that corresponds to the love of God, the gift of the creature who tries to be grateful for the divine Gift, the human cooperation that receives the loving and efficacious action of God. As divine love is eternal and its action constant, it is our part to have our heart always open to love, ready to receive the unspeakable gift.”



**Example:** Bulletin Notice of activity/ event: Event/Activity is January 14th-15th, 2023, notice of event for the bulletin needs to be received in the parish office January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2023. This is a hard deadline, so if the bulletin notice/announcement is not received in the parish office, it cannot be published.
