





We have been uniquely blessed for more than ten years with a model for faith formation that addresses the needs of the entire family, and not just children. We take seriously the Church's call for

parents to be the primary educators of their children, as well as the parish's role to support families in this mission.

The Family Faith Formation program meets once per month for families with children in kindergarten through middle school. Families have the option of coming on either Sunday afternoon or Monday evening. In addition there are prepared home lessons for parents to present to their children. Parents do not have to be experts in the faith, just willing to devote about an hour a week to quality family time in sharing the faith. All of the material is provided for parents and no additional research or study preparation is necessary to do the home lessons.

Understanding the busy schedules of today's families, the weekly lessons at home can be adapted to your own family schedule. This comprehensive program not only engages young children, noisy world. It serves as a means to re-focus our attention on Christ. it draws families together, and it equips parents to do a first-rate job in teaching the Catholic faith to their children. We are deeply committed to supporting parents every step of the way.



HIGH SCHOOL MINISTRY

As part of an effort to develop more effective, disciple -making youth ministry at Saint Mary Church we are continuing an exciting new initiative called Chosen.

The goal of Chosen is to offer your child a powerful, lifechanging experience as he or she prepares to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. If your child has already received the Sacrament of Confirmation and would like to go deeper in his/her faith with other teens, Chosen is the perfect opportunity for them too. 


