Reflection for This Sunday **“Living in the Hope of God’s Mercy”**

The readings this Sunday remind us of God’s deep and faithful love—a love stronger than death itself. The Book of Wisdom tells us, “*The souls of the just are in the hand of God, and no torment shall touch them.*” Even in moments of suffering or uncertainty, God’s promise of eternal peace holds us close.

St. Paul, in his letter to the Romans, reminds us that “*hope does not disappoint,*” because God’s love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit. Christ’s sacrifice reconciled us to God, not because we earned it, but because He loved us first.

In the Gospel, Jesus calls us to live out that same love in concrete ways—to see Him in the hungry, the thirsty, the stranger, the sick, and the imprisoned. Our faith becomes alive when it moves us to compassion.

As we reflect this week, may we be reminded that eternal life begins when we choose love today—when we serve, forgive, and open our hearts to others, we already begin to live in the kingdom of God.
