GOSPEL MEDITATION

In today's Gospel, Jesus calls us **salt and light**—simple things that quietly transform the world.

Salt gives flavor by disappearing into what it touches. Our faith does the same when it is lived with love, mercy, and integrity. Light does not fight the darkness; it simply shines. When we live our faith through good works, others are led to glorify God.

This Gospel is both a gift and a responsibility. Jesus believes in us enough to say you are—not you should be—salt and light. Even when we feel weak, ordinary, or unworthy, God chooses to work through us. Today, let us ask for the courage to live our faith authentically, to shine without fear, and to trust that God can use even our smallest acts of love to illuminate the world.

Prayer:

Lord Jesus, teach us to live quietly but faithfully, to bring hope where there is discouragement, and light where there is darkness.

May our lives point always to You. Amen.
