

Connecting to My Parish Family

"As the Father has sent Me, so I am sending you" John20:21

Dear Brothers and Sisters, the family is the heart of our parish — the **Domestic Church** where faith is first learned, love is shared, and prayer is born. When families come together to celebrate the Holy Eucharist and in service, our whole parish becomes stronger, more united, and more alive in Christ.

Based on our Bishop, the Most Rev. James P. Powers' Pastoral Letter on Evangelization, I come before you today as your priest to focus on two essential habits of discipleship—**Prayer** and **Relationship**—that help us grow and strengthen our parish community. - 2. Building relationships and praying among our families.
- 3. Experiencing Christ's love in practical life.
- 4. Supporting one another spiritually and practically.
- 5. Helping our children to get involved in family prayers.

Dear Brothers and Sisters, one thing I would like to ask of you is: please do not be afraid. This ministry is simple and easy. It involves families coming together once a month for only 30 to 40 minutes. The most important key to this ministry is saying your "Yes", just like Mother Mary, to help build another sacred Family of Nazareth within our parish community. Here are some very simple steps to get started:

- 1. Invite one or two families.






