PASTOR'S COLUMN – FR. JERRY HARRIS – DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

This weekend is Divine Mercy Sunday.

According to the USCCB, Divine Mercy Sunday (the Second Sunday of Easter) celebrates God's infinite love and compassion, encouraging believers to trust in Jesus' forgiveness and repent. Based on St. Faustina's revelations, it emphasizes receiving grace via Confession and Holy Communion, often using a dedicated action guide from the USCCB for parish celebrations.

The Key Aspects of Divine Mercy (USCCB Focus):

Divine Mercy Sunday: Established by Pope John Paul II in 2000, this day focuses on the "pouring out of graces upon souls," offering complete forgiveness of sins and punishment for those who participate in Confession and Holy Communion.

The Message: It is a call to trust that God's mercy is greater than any sin, particularly important in modern times to promote the dignity of human life.

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy: A devotion (often said on rosary beads) where believers offer to God the Body and Blood of Christ in atonement for sins.

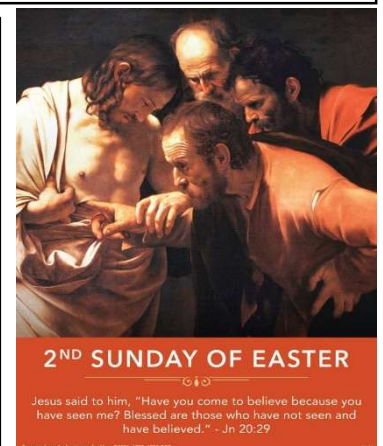
Healing & Pro-Life: The USCCB emphasizes Divine Mercy for healing, especially for those wounded by abortion, highlighting that God offers mercy to every repentant heart.

Divine Mercy Sunday

Where did the feast of Divine Mercy come from?

If you were born well before the year 2000, you know the feast of Divine Mercy has not always been celebrated in the Church. In the early 1900s, a young Polish nun began receiving private revelations. Jesus appeared to her during her times of prayer, speaking a message of mercy and love for the world. She received a set of prayers — the Divine Mercy Chaplet — and the request to have a feast day established to remind the Church of the mercy of God. St. Faustina died in 1938, on the cusp of war and in the midst of one of the most violent centuries in the history of the world.

Her story and her diaries began circulating in Poland and beyond. It quickly became apparent that this was a holy young woman, and the cause for her canonization opened. In the year 2000, she was canonized by the first-ever Polish pope, St. John Paul II. On her canonization day, he established the second Sunday of Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday, “a perennial invitation to the Christian world to face, with confidence in divine benevolence, the difficulties and trials that mankind with experience in the years to come.” ©LPi

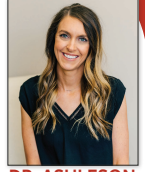

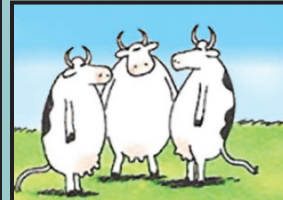
