





A MESSAGE FROM FR. BOB



Hello All,

Some of you have told me that you are happy that I have come to St. Mark parish. Coming here was my first choice. However, I do believe the Holy Spirit puts us where we are needed. The Holy Spirit led me here and the Holy Spirit has led you here as well. Some have said to me, that the parish needs a shot in the arm and are hoping that I can lead you all to a more vibrant parish life experience. Here are a few thoughts that I have on the topic and what I hope to accomplish here at St. Mark's Parish with your help.

Sometimes we can get comfortable and begin to think this is the way we have always done it. When we think this way in often leads to complacency, in my opinion. As your pastor, I am not just a priest but also the leader of an organization that requires management and leadership skills. Part of leading an organization is holding people accountable for excellence, which often involves difficult, uncomfortable, and loving conversations.

Coming this November, I will begin scheduling regular staff meetings, and meetings with all of you who volunteer and serve the parish in various ministries. We will discuss if we are truly serving the parish's needs or are just filling a slot. In order to make St. Mark parish the most dynamic parish in Boynton Beach we need to take some time to reevaluate ourselves and put into place the things that need improvement and to celebrate what we are already doing that is great.

I hope we can support one another as I go through the process of Leading St. Mark parish to become amazing. I know it can be hard and will take time. Change and self-evaluations can be difficult and challenging. It may involve hard conversations, suffering, opposition, criticism, but if we try with great humility we can and will be successful. Trying to avoid tough conversations and actions will only keep us from becoming an amazing parish and only lead to mediocrity.

I look forward to this journey as we pray together, discern together and implement the changes we need. When we do, this parish will truly be a breath of fresh air for Boynton Beach.

Parte de liderar una organización es responsabilizar a las personas por la excelencia, lo que a menudo implica conversaciones difíciles, incómodas y amorosas.

A partir de noviembre, comenzaré a programar reuniones regulares del personal y reuniones con todos ustedes que son voluntarios y sirven a la parroquia en varios ministerios. Discutiremos si realmente estamos sirviendo a las necesidades de la parroquia o si solo estamos llenando un espacio. Para hacer de la parroquia de San Marcos la parroquia más dinámica de Boynton Beach, necesitamos tomarnos un tiempo para reevaluarnos y poner en marcha las cosas que necesitan mejorar y celebrar lo que ya estamos haciendo que es excelente.

Espero que podamos apoyarnos unos a otros a medida que avanzo en el proceso de liderar la parroquia de San Marcos para que se vuelva increíble.. Sé que puede ser difícil y llevará tiempo. El cambio y las autoevaluaciones pueden ser difíciles y desafiantes. 
