Music Notes: Starting at the Christmas Midnight Mass, we will begin singing the Gloria in Latin at the 4 p.m. and 11 a.m. Masses. The setting we are using is from Gregorian Mass VIII "De Angelis." Many of you may be familiar with it already, with its beautiful, soaring, lyrical melody. It might be a common misunderstanding that singing in Latin and Gregorian Chant is "not in the Spirit of Vatican II" or "regressive." But that is not the case! In fact, the Council Fathers wanted Latin and chant to be preserved. From Musicam Sacram, the directive on Sacred Music from Vatican II: "47. According to the Constitution on the Liturgy, "the use of the Latin language, with due respect to particular law, is to be preserved in the Latin rites.... the faithful may also be able to say or sing together in Latin those parts of the Ordinary of the Mass which pertain to them" and "Gregorian chant, as proper to the Roman liturgy, should be given pride of place, other things being equal." But perhaps my favorite explanation is from Sing to the Lord, the most recent directive by the USCCB on music in the American Catholic Church: "Gregorian chant is uniquely the Church's own music. Chant is a living connection with our forebears in the faith, the traditional music of the Roman rite, a sign of communion with the universal Church, a bond of unity across cultures, a means for diverse communities to participate together in song, and a summons to contemplative participation in the Liturgy." That to me, sums up perfectly why chant belongs in the modern church. The Gloria belongs to the Ordinary of the Mass; that is, the parts of the Mass that do not change from week to week. The Ordinary is considered, before the hymns and propers, the first and foremost music for the people to sing. I do want to stress that this does not mean the end of English in the Liturgy! This is an addition, and does not mean other things will be subtracted. Singing the Gloria in Latin will engage us in something that is ever ancient, but ever new. I invite you to go to the music page on our parish website and listen and follow along with this beautiful chant, along with other seasonal music.

Church Renovations

Over the years, we have been looking at the possibility of replacing the heavy kneelers with a lighter, safer version. Upgrading the kneelers meant giving consideration to upgrading the floor. We also wanted to consider the possible relocation of the bathrooms for better accessibility. In consultation with the Archdiocese of Boston, we hired an architect to evaluate these needs and make suitable recommendations and proposed designs. The new design provides for new flooring and kneelers throughout the church. This will entail the lifting and re-setting of the original pews in such fashion as to allow more room and easier access, while also complying with the current building code. We will also be restoring the original architectural design of the church altar rail, to be located across the first step of the sanctuary currently where the green carpet is.

Unfortunately, moving the bathrooms to the front vestibule was not practical. The utilities for the church all come in through the sacristy and there is no underground basement in the church. Therefore, running water and sewer pipes from the sacristy to the vestibule would have entailed formidable work and prohibitive expense. The new design will construct a ramp into the sacristy allowing greater accessibility to the bathrooms as well as the chapel (and confessional). This design also levels the sacristy floor and partitions 1/3rd of the sacristy for priests vesting area.


Specifications were drawn by the architect and bids were made by contractors approved by the Archdiocese of Boston Facilities Office. Citywide Contracting won the bid and was awarded the contract. The work is scheduled to begin in January. (Please see floor plan diagram below.)

In order to complete this renovation in a timely manner, we will be closing the church for the month of January with a planned reopening the first weekend of February. Sunday Masses for the month of January will be held in the school cafeteria and daily Mass will be moved to the chapel. Saint Timothy Parish is graciously working with us to facilitate funerals at Saint Timothy Church for January. Saint Catherine priests and music ministry and servers will still minister our parishioners' funerals, albeit at Saint Timothy for the month of January.

We understand the strong bond many have for Saint Catherine Church and regret the necessary but temporary imposition. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we undergo this important work to help maintain and improve our beautiful church.

I am grateful to our staff whose assistance has been to initiate and complete the many vital projects throughout the parish. Special thanks to all our generous parishioners who make the continued care and improvements of the church and school possible.


