

Blessed & Merry Christmas

There is something in the medical field called "gene therapy." According to the Mayo Clinic, gene therapy involves altering faulty or diseased genes inside your body with healthy ones. It involves the smallest elements within the gene, the DNA. So, what does this have to do with Christmas?

Well, the Gospel reading on Christmas Eve has a long version, rarely chosen, called, The Genealogy of Jesus; you know, the one that goes; Amminadab became the father of Nashon...Shealtiel the father of Zerubbabel... etc. It involves all kinds of Biblical characters dating back throughout salvation history. But why does the Church give us that Gospel reading of all times on Christmas Eve?

Well, just as gene therapy aims to bring healing and medicine to the root cause of illness in the depth of the human person, so too does God, in Jesus Christ. God becomes man in Jesus Christ, entering fully into our human nature. As C.S. Lewis described it, Jesus went into enemy - occupied territory, to root out sin and evil. He entered the human soul, woven in our flesh, hidden in our humanity. As the gene is to the body, so the soul is to man. Like rewriting the genetic code or DNA, Jesus rewrites the "soul code" of the human person, restoring us to our original justice and nature, created in God's Image and Likeness, before the fall of sin.


In Divine Grace, Jesus is our saving medicine, the medicine of immortality working from the inside out. It is not magic but grace, the choice of grace and the choice of conforming ourselves to the life of Jesus and allowing His Divine Life in us. To the willing soul, the Lord infuses divine grace through the sacramental life of His Church. This saving grace enlightens our inner soul, which informs our entire being in grace and truth. This is why Jesus is called the Light and Life and the Light of the world, the Light that shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it.

As we celebrate Christmas, we rightly recognize and identify it as a time of light, the Light of Christ, the Star of Bethlehem, the brilliance of angels singing in the fields. We too are called to reflect the light of Christ, an enlightened body and soul. The Lord said to His disciples; "you are the light of the world and the salt of the earth... Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."

Only by drawing close to the Light of Christ can we reflect that light and warmth in our families and the world around us. May our Church be ever filled with the joyful worship and praise of Christmas.



 Parish Envelopes — If you are not enrolled in online giving and you regularly contribute to offertory at Mass, we encourage you to receive envelopes so we can credit you with your donations. Contact the parish office, and we can assist you.

3. If online giving is not an option for you, and you are not able to attend Mass, you can mail your donation or drop it off at the rectory using the mail slot in the front door. For security reasons, we ask you to not leave envelopes in the external mailbox. Thank you!

Please do not kneel if it is difficult for you. If you are not able to come forward, please remain in your bench and a priest or deacon will come to you.




